- The DOC will report to the EBOD.
- Rich is hoping to finalize US Soccer affiliation.
- The Fall 2006 referee and team requirement will be further discussed on next month's meeting.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Rule change on 3.08 (e) was passed after a motion was made by Pam and seconded by Will. All in favor, none opposed.

The money will be out of the league account. The clinics will be held in Reno, Sparks, Carson City, Incline, Tahoe and other outlying areas.
