- Rich had asked Jeff not to accept any money from anyone until we hear from the State as this program has not been approved as of yet. And if this program is approved, we shouldn't send the money to the South. It should be kept here in the North.
- Per Pam our so called ODP team is far from comparison to another team. Will stated that ODP is individual training.
- Jeff had acquired a commitment from 5 different schools to come and observe or players.

- Rule change of 3.02 “one year age limitation” was passed with 7 in favor 0 opposed and 1 abstain.
- A new Bylaw 2:10 was presented to the Board. Pam made a motion to pass this bylaw, Heather seconded the motion. All in favor none opposed.

## NEW BUSINESS

- The board asked to increase the registration fee. Several propositions were heard and a motion to pass the increase in the spring was made by Pam and seconded by Will Allen. The fees will be \$100.00 per player in the spring and \$50.00 per player in the fall.
- Referee assignor fees are presented to the board as such: \$4.00 per game to Pam Calhoun and \$2.00 per game to Stacy Perez. A motion to pass this proposal was made by Will and seconded by Richard Jay. This is effective fall of 2006.
- Referee annual policy asked for more referee training.
- Terrace Park would need \$38,000.00 to refurbish. Rich had suggested to RYSA for GBYSL to take over the field maintenance. RYSA gave the approval. Dave Aiazia will head this project. Will made a motion to approve the project and is seconded by Richard. All in favor none opposed one abstained.
- Heather asked to open the discussion about head of Coaching. Rich reiterated that the clubs are responsible to teach their coaches and it is not the league’s responsibility. He will add this issue in next month’s meeting. Pam will also take this issue to the State.
- Pam asked for committee members to take control of the worst behaviors of coaches and parents. Richard Jay and Heather Johnson will be the members.
