CAPITAL SOCCER

- There have been concerns regarding the two year rule. This ruling will eventually hurt the small clubs. It was suggested that this clubs should refer the kids to other clubs for membership.

CARSON VALLEY

- There are 10-11 teams registering in the spring.

RSU

- There was a lot of interest on the referee program when it was presented in the pre-season meeting.
- Tryouts are going on tonight and the numbers look really good. They are expecting to register more teams.

SAGEBRUSH SOCCER CLUB

- The Start-Up Tournament is on March 24 and 25, 2007. The club is going to accept a maximum of 90 teams. The fee is \$395.00.

SIERRA SOCCER

- Tryouts are going on. They are expecting new teams.

SPANISH SPRINGS SOCCER CLUB

- The first tryout went well. 2 girls team will be added in the spring.

STATE DUP

- Boys and girls U-13, 14, 16, and 17 will be held here in Reno on May 19 and 20. 8 teams will be represented from each age group. We are going to use Edmonds Field.
- Scott Conner will need a total of 65 referees. A 4 man team will be available per game. The referee association in Las Vegas and Sacramento will be helping. Airport Plaza is the host hotel. A meeting this Thursday will be held for field and concession. GBYSL and Capital Soccer will provide nets. All the clubs participation is a must.
- If there are more than two teams per age division applying from the north, a play off will be held.

OLD BUSINESS

- Larry Calhoun will contact the West Coast representative regarding our league's affiliation with US Club Soccer. The US Club Soccer has coaching classes that's equivalent to ODP. Each team has to carry their player cards.

NEW BUSINESS

- A meeting on Monday, Nov. 20 will be held for referee disciplinary committee.
- A suggestion was raised that the club should have their own Director of Coaching and it is not the responsibility of the league. The DOC according to the job description put together will be overseeing all the teams. But being that we have a big number of teams, the DOC will only be able to look at the team once a season. The DOC should educate coaches, hold coaching clinics and should show coaches per age division the direction their team needs to go according to Jeff. This program will be a big financial stress to the league. An advisory vote was taken, 5 yes and 5 no on whether we need to pursue this further. Rich broke the tie by voting to pursue the matter more. This will be added on the January meeting.
- Premier 90-91 was suggested by Will to be part of GBYSL program. A lot of older players do not want to participate in the ODP program because of past experiences. Discussion was followed by this motion and it was voted to pull this motion from the agenda.
- Jimmy Huynh was voted to the Recreational Commissioner. He accepted the position.

- Ron of CVSC has a combination of U-16 and 17 boys players. He is asking the board to allow his U-15 son to play with the team. He has been with the team for 7 years. A motion was made by Tim to allow the player to play U-17 unconditionally and the vote was 3 yes and 7 no. Arne made motion to allow the player to play on U017 games only and the vote was 8 yes and 3 nos.
- Mike Gibbons requested to let a U-14 player play up on a U-16 team. A motion to deny the player to play up was raised by Randy and seconded by Richard Jay. 9 yes, 0 no and 2 abstains.
- Reno Magic, a U-14 team has asked to play down again this season. Te board recommended that the team should join the Recreational division this season and depending on how the team performs, the team can move up to the competitive division the following year upon the board's approval.
- Terry, UNR women's soccer head coach spoke to Rich and demanded for the \$2500.00 grant that we gave to them last year by December 1st. The board voted for Rich to re-negotiate with Terry. We can also look at using Damonte Ranch High School, WNCC. This motion was made by Richard J. and seconded by Jimmy H. All in favor none opposed.

GOOD OF THE GAME

- Stacy had spoken to the owner of Western Turf about the usage of their turf for the upcoming State Cup.
- Dean together with Richard and Rich will meet with Doolittle regarding the filed usage fee.

Dean made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 p.m.
