Minutes from February was presented to the Board. Pam made a motion to approve the minutes with the following changes: Micro 6 is on March 31 and April 1st and NIAA should be USSF and seconded by Ralph. All in favor none opposed.

Board reports:

President

- The scheduling had been a problem this year. There are several things to take into consideration such as creation of team brackets (the clubs were invited to rate the teams from their club) referee request, league request, tournaments, request for double headers to name a few. A request from a specific team had created an issue that we have to address tonight. The league has to set boundaries for an employee to make decisions on scheduling.

Treasurer

- Report was handed out. The general account has a balance of \$96,087.00 and the field account has \$97,502.15.
- The 1099 was a problem this year as far as getting it out on time. For this upcoming season, no checks will be issued to anyone unless the treasurer has a record of the Social Security number.

League Commissioner

- The referee turnout has been great. Each referee has three games and a few had about 4 games.
- Scott Connor will be at the Sagebrush tournament to assess the referees for the upcoming State Cup. Adidas, the national sponsor wrote us a \$10,000.00 check.

Northern VP

- There is a total of 29 teams from the North and 115 from the South. Seven divisions has 3 teams that will have a playoff. Out of state players are allowed to play in the state cup as long as they are registered players in Nevada.

State Cup Committee

- Everything is all in order. A representative from the South came and Ron, Richard Jay and Dean all gave him a tour of the facility in Edmonds Field. The concession stand is the only problem we're having. We might have to use the trailer from Carson High School.

NEW BUSINESS

- Should there be a written policy for every item. This became an issue when a team requested 5 league games only. Vicki authorized this since the league had accommodated this requests from years before.
- Tahoe Tempest, a U-14 team is requesting to register a U-12 player. Randy V., a national diplomacy coach will assess the player and report to the board next month. Stacy made a motion not to allow this player to play up and Jimmy seconded.
- Bill Layman requested to let his U-12 player play on U-14 team. Pam made a motion to allow this player to play up and Russell seconded. All in favor none opposed. Motion carries.
- Randi V, a U-17 team is requesting to play in U-19 tournament. All in favor none opposed. Motion carries.

- Lester Lopez, born on September 1993, a U-13 player, is requesting to play in a U-15 team. Tony made a motion to allow this player to play up, Russell seconded. All in favor none opposed. Motion carries.
- Dynasty, a U-17 team is requesting to register 3 U-15 players. A motion was made by Larry to allow this players to play on U-17 games only, seconded by Dean. All in favor, 1 opposed, 3 abstained. Motion carries.
- GBYSL is now a fully sanctioned US Club Soccer. A committee consisted of Will, Larry, Vicki, Russell, Rich, Jimmy and Dean is formed.
- Profanity will not be tolerated at all. Yellow card will be issued for each time a foul language is used. The second yellow card will be a red card.
- The players on the bench are required to wear vest. Taping of jewelry is not allowed.
- Terri Kish presented to the Board her frustrations with the game scheduling. It was stopped by the Board because of Terri's unprofessional manner.

- Rick Wendling asked the board to please ask the coaches to stop using the word "freaking, suck and other vulgar words" during the game.

Rich made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 p.m. and is seconded by Pam.
