Secretary Report: Tom Jasurda motioned - Lonny Techel 2nd to approve June minutes. Motion carried

Treasurer Report: Tom Jasurda gave the board an overview of the financial statements through June 2007. The final ice bill for the 06/07 season was paid (\$17,000) Rich Bruns motioned to approve the budget. Motioned was seconded by Ryan Berdal, motioned carried. Jeff Dennis asked how many EYH skaters signed up for Spring League and we were told it was mostly Wausau skaters who participated in Spring League. Lonny Techle stated it could use more organization and structure.

Sponsorship committee is off to a good start. Anyone interested in recruiting a sponsor will receive a 12.5% spiff. This spiff can be used as a credit to reduce your families fundraising obligations.

"Stars of Tomorrow Camp" organized by Joe Babiar and Coach DuVair will fund itself, there are no limits on number of participants, goalies will have a reduced fee, at 20 participant the camp will break even, Joe suggested the first \$1,000 of profit be given as a donation to Everest High School Hockey.

Website is not able to host the 6500 club but skaters are encouraged to print out the calendar and track their shots. Families will be able to combine calendars so they can view multiple levels on one calendar. Example a family with a mite and a bantam could print out a schedule that would list both skaters' games. New updated website will be easier for team managers to use. Website also included registration and buyouts this year.

Sponsorship: There was a sponsorship blitz held July 20th six individuals from EYH participated in canvassing the Everest Area asking for sponsorship. All banners will be updated in August.
