Notes:

1. If only one referee officiates a game, they receive two vouchers.
2. The Official must be paid by cash or check at the end of the game if the team does not supply a voucher. Additional vouchers can be purchased by contacting the Treasurer.
3. The Scorekeeper must sign the voucher if the Team Manager is unavailable.
4. The Official must enter his/her Referee ID #. A listing is located in the Referee Room. If an ID has not been assigned, enter "NEW".
5. If the Official does not receive a voucher or payment at the end of the game, they need to contact the following (in order of priority):
 - Team Manager
 - Referee-in-Chief
 - HHA Vice President of Hockey Operations
