

Codes of Conduct

It is the mission of the Blackhills Football Club (BHFC) to support the development of high-level soccer within District 7. The Blackhills Football Club supports the development of soccer skills and player commitment to allow play at the highest level of competition possible. The BHFC program emphasizes individual player development rather than team accomplishments. It is the goal of the Blackhills Football Club to provide top-caliber coaching, training, and competition for players in District 7.

The Blackhills Football Club endorses the following values: personal responsibility; good sportsmanship; honesty; respect for ones parents, teammates, coaches, game officials, and opponents; fairness; and team work. We believe soccer is a tremendous game that should be played for fun and the challenge of competition. We hope that the BHFC program builds the foundation for a life-long love of the game as a participant, coach, and spectator. The Blackhills Football Club believes that it is important that players, coaches, and parents representing the Club provide positive examples of behavior both on and off the field. For this reason the following Codes of Conduct were developed for coaches, players, and parents. These Codes have been adopted by representatives of all BHFC teams.

Violations:

Actions by coaches, players, or parents that are felt to be in violation of these codes of conduct should be brought to the attention of the Blackhills Football Club Ethics Committee which is composed of team representatives. A Team Representative, Board member, coach, or the Coaching Director (James Charette) should be contacted to begin the process of setting up a hearing before the Ethics Committee. If possible, confidentiality will be preserved.
