



Record of Soccer Goal Inspection

INSPECT ALL GOALS TO INSURE THAT:

ALL SOCCER GOALS are properly secured and anchored at all times, so they will not fall over from excessive weight or wind.

All goals not presently in use are stored safely in such a manner that they can't be moved or tipped over and pose no immediate danger.

Coaches should be instructed to inspect all soccer goals prior to games and practice, to ensure they are securely anchored and safe. They should also warn players and parents of the dangers of portable goals. Any open hooks used to attach nets have been removed; There are no rusted or weak areas on the posts or crossbar; There are no jagged or sharp points or edges on the posts.
