NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANT:

WBBA will request a background check of you from the superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension. As the subject of such a background check, you have the following rights:

1. The right to be informed that WBBA will request a background check on you:
 - i) for purposes of your application to volunteer with WBBA or for purposes of continuing as a volunteer; and
 - ii) to determine whether you have been convicted of any crime specified in Minnesota Statutes §299C.61, subdivision 2 or 4;
2. The right to be informed by WBBA of the superintendent's response to the background check and to obtain from WBBA a copy of the background check report;
3. The right to obtain from the superintendent any record that forms the basis for the report;
4. The right to challenge the accuracy and completeness of any information contained in the report or record pursuant to section 13.04, subdivision 4;
5. The right to be informed by WBBA if your application to volunteer with a children's service provider, or to continue as a volunteer, has been denied because of the superintendent's response; and
6. The right not to be required directly or indirectly to pay the cost of the background check.
