Consent, Release, & Indemnity Agreement

We the undersigned, for and in consideration of providing the undersigned Player with the opportunity to participate in Trojan Youth Lacrosse, do hereby unconditionally release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Trojan Youth Lacrosse, Simpson Middle School, Mabry Middle School, McCleskey Middle School, the Cobb County School System, the City of Marietta, or any person, coach, volunteer or entity employed by or associated with any of them from any and all claims for personal injury, death, property damage or any type of claim or damage (including, but not limited to, attorney's fees and litigation expenses) resulting from or arising out of the undersigned Player's participation in the sport of lacrosse or transportation to and from events with Trojan Youth Lacrosse.

We, the undersigned, hereby consent and grant to the coach or volunteers of Trojan Youth Lacrosse with the express authority and discretion, but not the requirement, to provide any medical or emergency services needed by the undersigned Player during his/her participation in the sport of lacrosse with the undersigned parent/guardian being financially responsible for such services.

The undersigned represents the Player is physically and psychologically able and prepared to participate in the sport of lacrosse, and understands and accepts the fact that sports participation, including lacrosse, involves risk of injury and bodily harm, including but not limited to, paralysis and death. These risks are voluntarily and knowingly assumed by the undersigned.

Player and Parent Conduct Pledge

I am expected to demonstrate sportsmanship and ethical conduct at all times, in support of fair play and respect for the sport of lacrosse and the facility at which the game is played.

I understand that unsportsmanlike conduct will NOT be tolerated. Any unsportsmanlike act (includes fighting, profane language, excessive physical play) could result in not being allowed to participate in practices and/or games and forfeiture of all registration fees.

I understand that the use of non-prescribed drugs or illegal substances, including alcohol, could result in being removed from a roster for the current season for a first-time offense, and forfeiture of all registration fees; a second offense will deny the player from further participation in the game of lacrosse with Trojan Youth Lacrosse and will result in forfeiture of all registration fees. The Trojan Youth Lacrosse program reserves the right to impose further action, depending upon the severity of the infraction.
