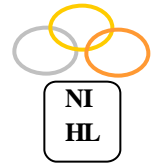

## FIRST YEAR PEEWEE INSTRUCTIONAL CHECKING CLINIC DECLARATION

A minimum of a two-hour checking instruction clinic is required for all players moving up to or playing PeeWee level of hockey for the first time.

Organizations are responsible for either administering a checking clinic, or confirming that all of their first-year players have taken at least a two-hour checking clinic. Goalies are not required to take the clinic unless they plan to skate up; however, they may want to be included in an off-ice video or chalk talk session reviewing checking instruction.

**This form is to be completed in full and submitted by your organization's registrar. This form must be submitted for all first year players who participate in the current NIHL playing season.**

**DEADLINE FOR THIS FORM: The registrar must submit this form along with its corresponding Team Information Report prior to or on the **SCHEDULING DAY** for the current playing season.**
