

EYH Values Program

EYH will be providing each tournament Eligible team with money toward tournament fees once all members of the team complete their charitable act and the manager turns in the form.

The team manager will be responsible for ensuring that each member of the team completes his or her charitable act. The goal of the program is to have the team identify an act that they are able to do as a team. This act will help show our community what EYH is about, provide exposure to our kids, and help build teamwork.

If a player is not able to attend the team charitable act due to timing, conflicts or illness then with preapproved permission of the team manager, a player may complete his/her act on their own.

Once teams are selected, each team will need to meet to discuss and decide upon the team activity they are going to complete. Suggestions are:

- Visiting a nursing home and sing carols, play bingo, etc.
- Making cookies and delivering to friends, neighbors and family (those that helped with your fundraising)
- Making cards to send to those in the armed forces
- Collecting food for one of the shelters
- Ringing bells for the Salvation Army
- Raking leaves, before the snowfalls for someone in need of help
- Helping and donating at one of the local church festivals
- Setting up can collection and donating the money to a charity

Please be creative in what you pick and consider joining up with other teams in your act.
