This special meeting was called to discuss the Bantam program. At the last board meeting a motion was passed on how EYH was going to handle the movement of players depending on how many were taken for the High School team. The issue came about when the head coach of the Bantam A team took a different direction than what the board had approved. There were a number of issues all breaking down to a lack of communication between the board, coaches, players, and parents.

A motion was made by Barb to retract the motion made at the November 12<sup>th</sup> board meeting requiring an equal # of players to move up from the Pee Wee program in order to keep two bantam teams. Motion was seconded by Lonny and was approved.

Additional discussion took place regarding how to handle this issue in future years and included:

- No Bantam games until after Thanksgiving
- Bantams participate in tryouts at the same time as the rest of EYH but no teams posted until after the High School team is picked
- Number of players needed to make a team
- How does EYH contact Pee Wee player that may be asked to move up
- Early contact with Bantams and parents on plans to make up teams
- Adding these topics to the handbook

Will a player be able to double roster? Yes

Defined - Primary allegiance is to the team of the skater made during tryouts. However, is able to help with a higher team were there is a need.

Need is 9 or less skaters due to injury or illness or low numbers, To double roster the skater has to be a second year player and will be based on try out numbers.

Example of higher level would be mite to squirt, squirt to peewee, and peewee to bantam.

Coaches' spouses are not able to be managers of a team. If the spouse wishes to manage, the coach needs to step down.
