New Berlin Soccer Club

- NBSC is a non-profit, 100% volunteer ran Club. NBSC is a member of the Milwaukee Kickers Soccer Club which has over 8,000 players and 650 teams throughout SE WI.
- NBSC includes nearly 900 youth players; 55 teams at the U7 and up ages and 6 teams for U6.
- NBSC has girls, boys, and coed - recreational soccer teams ranging from U6 to U18 and select level teams from U11 up.
- NBSC strives to provide a fun, educational atmosphere for kids to learn and develop their soccer skills. We promote fun, exercise, and the formation of friendships.

NBSC Benefits

- NBSC has a very dedicated board made up of parent volunteers, coaches and adult players that can provide answers or direction for coaches and parents alike.
- NBSC pays for referees at the U7 / U8 ages as a benefit to the younger teams. Kickers does not pay for or provide referees at the U7 or U8 ages.
- NBSC strives to keep teams / coaches together from year to year. Unless a change is specifically requested, players will remain with their teammates and coaching staff through the recreational years.
- Alliance teams have professional coaching staff that typically stay with the team for two years in order to expose players to new ideas.
- NBSC provides many opportunities for both player and coach development.

NBSC Registration Fees

*** The NBSC soccer season is both Fall and Spring. Certain age groups however are offered the ability to play for spring only.**

Fee Examples (for Full Season):

U6: Kickers = \$75 NBSC = \$20 / TOTAL = \$95.00

U9: Kickers = \$125 NBSC = \$50 / TOTAL = \$175.00

U11: Kickers = \$130 NBSC = \$50 / TOTAL = \$180.00

Registration fees are paid when you register online, at www.mksc.org. Prior to each season there may be established registration deadlines. If you register after this deadline, late fees may apply.

Uniforms / Practices

- Player registration covers two seasons – Fall and the following Spring.
- Uniforms are issued every Fall and are worn for two seasons.
- Players keep the uniforms at the end of the Spring season.
- Practices are held at local parks as assigned by the club.
- Teams are scheduled for 2 practices per week.
- Practice fields typically open about 1 month prior to the first league games, weather permitting

Games and Tournaments

- All games are played in the metro Milwaukee area
- Fall game schedules consist of league games, New Berlin Fall Classic Tournament games and usually one indoor soccer game (U7 and up).
- Spring game schedules consist of league games. U8 and under teams have one extra game at the Kickers Kicknic.
- Regular season games are on Saturdays and Sundays.
- New Berlin Fall Classic Tournament is held the 2nd weekend of September and consists of three (3) games.
- Additional tournament or indoor league participation is optional.
