You will be prompted to change your password after the first time you sign in. Please change your password to something you can remember and put it in a safe place for future use. WAA will not have access to your password but there will be ability for us to reset your passwords. After you have signed on, please update all of your family information and provide a current email address that we can use to communicate with you.

More information on the online registration process will be coming out shortly; we will be sending a flyer home with the elementary students near the end of January. You will be responsible for obtaining a password to get into online registrations.

## Become A Member of the WAA Track Team or The Traveling Track Team!

With fall weather and snowflakes fast approaching, ones thoughts may not be focused on spring and its upcoming track program. However, spring sports sign-ups are just around the corner. Spring sports sign-ups, including track & field will take place in February. Watch for the upcoming dates in the next newsletter. WAA Track Program's mission is to enhance the skills of young runners and introduce them to the sport of Track & Field. The club has a goal of developing each person's leadership potential both on and off the track and field. The club is looking for kids who enjoy competing and have some interest in, track and field or just running to enhance their overall fitness.

### Practice

Practices will be held twice a week for one hour (in the past practices have taken place on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:00 to 7:00 P.M. The season will start in May and run into July as determined by the state meet date for 2008. The practice format provides flexibility for athletes that participate in other sports (i.e. soccer, softball, baseball) or activities (i.e., gymnastics or dance) that coincide with our season. The club asks that you attend all practices that you are able to but does not require attendance at every practice. Also families and athletes often have vacations or other plans that occur during the summer. The club attempts to keep our focus on sport in perspective, recognizing that family comes first.

### Competition

Prior to the start of the track & field season, each participant will receive a "welcome" letter on-line, (or hard copy if requested) that outlines all of the available meets for us. Participants pick which meets they will attend, and participate in as many, or as few meets as they choose.

### Joining

You may stop in the WAA office during regular operat-

ing hours to register (typically open Monday-Friday from 2:00 to 6:00 P.M.) But call 731-0100 to verify hours.

A Welcome Letter with additional information will be sent out at the end of April.

### Coaching Philosophy

The program is based on introducing and refining the sport of Track & Field through a positive feedback coaching process. This process emphasizes fundamentals, fitness, flexibility and form. Most important however, is the presentation of running as a fun, enjoyable, and rewarding athletic activity that can become a life-long healthy lifestyle.

### Cost of the Program

The cost of the program for the 2008 season will run between \$75.00 for the in-house program and \$125.00 for the traveling (competitive) program. This cost includes a running singlet & shorts, the coaching, and fees for the WAA home meets.

For those of you that would like to find out more about coaching or assisting a coach, please contact me as soon as possible. We will be holding our annual Track coaches meeting in January to discuss the upcoming season, its needs and the direction of the program.

## **Changes coming in 2008**

The Woodbury Soccer Club (WSC) will be undergoing many changes during 2008 of which we are very excited. First and foremost, we are currently in the process of replacing our current website with an updated version which we hope will be much more informative for our members. Our address ([www.woodburysoccer.com](http://www.woodburysoccer.com)) should not change as we move to our new site, so we encourage you to keep an eye out for the switch, and let us know what you think.

Secondly, hopefully by the time this is printed we will have hired our new Director of Coaching (DOC). As this is written, we are interviewing some quality candidates who should be able to step into this role and provide an immediate impact. While we do not expect to make any drastic changes to our league offerings right away, internally we hope to rely on this soccer professional to play a more visible role in the organization.

In addition to having a more visible and interactive Director of Coaching, we also will be changing the overall structure of the WSC board. While the actual titles of the new board are still being determined at the time of writing this article, the plan is to have a Board of Directors with seven members, each a parent/volunteer. These individuals will be tasked with providing general oversight of the club as a whole, as well as planning for the future, relying on the new DOC for providing direction and leadership of the soccer programs themselves. The more administrative tasks of the club will then be handled by parent/volunteers at the Coordinator level. By expanding the number of Coordinator level positions, we will be giving more parents the ability to give some time and effort to helping the club, without the additional burden of attending board meetings or the stigma of being considered part of the board. ## **Spring Developmental Program updates**

### **U6/U8 Registrations**

#### **U5-U6**

Children under/still 6 yrs. of age by July 31, 2008  
Children must be 5 years old by May 1, 2008

#### **U7-U8**

Children under/still 8 yrs. of age by July 31, 2008

Head coaches fees are waived. We are always in need of coaches. Please sign up early to help get the program a jump start. The cost is \$95 dollars and this includes training, practice, games and a complete uniform shirt, shorts and socks. Anyone registering on March 1, 2008 or later will have a \$20 late fee. There will be a \$20 administration fee for all players dropping out after registering. There will also be NO REFUNDS after April 1, 2008. Registrations received after Feb 28th, 2008 will be put on a waiting list and will be notified of any openings.

This program starts the 3rd week of April and ends the 3<sup>rd</sup> week in July; weather providing. There will be Technical Director training sessions provided at the start of the season. We continue after that with one practice and one game per week for 8 weeks.

### **Spring U8 Intro to Traveling Soccer offering**

Another change coming in 2008 will be an additional offering for U8 players in the Spring Developmental program. This year we will be offering those who are interested the opportunity to play on a U8 Rec-Plus team. These teams will practice twice a week, and then play a weekly game against near by soccer clubs on Saturday mornings. In addition, these teams will be entitled and encouraged to participate in tournaments available to Rec-Plus teams through the Minnesota Youth Soccer Association (MYSA). The intent of this new offering will be to prepare these participants for the transition to the Competitive program at U9. Pricing for this program will be \$120, and registration will still be conducted through the new WAA registration system. NOTE, this is voluntary, the original U8 format will still be offered. # GOLF

The WAA Golf Program offers recreational play and lessons during a ten week season each summer. Leagues do not play during the week of July 4th. Players range in age from 4 to 19 years old. Teams and tee times are assigned for the season. Vouchers are available for pre-arranged absences and rain checks are provided except as noted below. Awards and trophies are based on individual performance.

The WAA Golf Program offers six leagues:

**Bogey League** ~ Plays at Cimmarron and provides coached lessons as golfers play a round of golf. No rain checks are provided.

**Ealge Leauge** ~ Plays at Cimmarron and provides a short par three course for golfers who are learning to be independent. There is a League Supervisor and a League Ranger to watch over the players. No rain checks are provided.

**Birdie League** ~ Plays at Ponds of Battle Creek and provides independent play for those in the Intermediate I group. There is a Golf League Supervisor on the course to organize team play.

**Herron League** ~ Plays at Oak March and provides independent play and practice on the long drives for those in the Intermediate II group.

**Double Eagle 9'er.** ~ Plays at Eagle Valley for 9 holes: either front or back is assigned for the season. There is a Golf League Supervisor on the course to organize team play. Fro the accomplished golfers.

**Double Eagle** ~ Plays 18-hole rounds at Eagle Valley. There is a Golf League Supervisor on the course to organize team play.
