Registration

On-Line registration is now complete and we are planning for the upcoming season. If you still need to register, please do so as soon as possible so we can effectively plan. At this point a late fee of \$20 is assessed for in-house grades 3 – 12, and a late fee of \$40 for traveling grades 4 – 9. Late fees are not assessed for grades 1 and 2; however we encourage you to sign up soon so we know the number of participants.

Registration is early so we can register our teams for tournaments. The registration process for tournaments begins in mid July.

SUMMER FOOTBALL CLINIC

SUMMER 2008 JR. ROYALS FOOTBALL CLINIC With Head Coach Beau LaBore

You may register at the WAA Building during normal business hours. You may also download a Mail-in CLINIC Registration Form from www.waafootball.com or register on-line at www.waa.woodbury.org.

Coach LaBore will be directing our Football Skills Clinic incorporating the "Coaching To Change Lives" Curriculum. This will be a high quality football clinic designed for first time players as well as current players. These clinics are designed for football skills – passing, catching, running, kicking, punting, etc. There will be competitions and 7-on-7 each day.

Jr. Royals Football Clinics are being offered for players entering the 1st - 6th Grades in fall of 2008. Two Sessions are being held in two-week increments on Monday – Friday.

Clinic II July 14th – July 18th

1st - 6th Grade Clinics will be held from *noon to 2 pm* simultaneously on two separate fields @ BSC. Bad weather days will be held indoors @ BSC. Clinic costs will be **\$65.00**. If you attend both Clinics, the second one will be only \$45.00. Enrollment is limited to 200 players each session.

These clinics have been scheduled to not conflict with any other sports being played this summer.

Coaching Certification

For those who are interested in coaching ANY WAA Sport, **Coaching Certification Training** is now required by our WAA Executive Board. There are two phases to the Certification – **non-sport specific** (refer to specific WAA published information and dates in March) and **sport specific** training as described below. If you completed your non-sport specific training in 2006 or 2007, you **do not** have to re-take it this year. **EVE-RYONE** is required to take our **Football sport-specific** this June.

NOTE: This is REQUIRED by the Woodbury Athletic Association and supported by WAA Youth Developmental Football.

New MEYFL (Metro East Youth Football League) now in business for 2008 Football season.

The emphasis and philosophy of a positive youth sports culture from years past will remain as the cornerstone of the new MEYFL. The focus shall remain on “youth developmental football” featuring equal balanced teams and equal playing time. There will be little noticeable differences from the previous organization as well as very few rule adjustments. This new League will require a little more travel time to other communities. Permanent Member Communities are Woodbury, Upper East Side (UES), Oakdale, and Mahtomedi. North St. Paul will be participating this Season on a trial basis. WAA Football is a Developmental Football League focused on teaching fundamentals of the game to our Woodbury Youth. We believe in creating a positive youth sports culture demonstrating our commitment to offering all youth athletes a positive, character-building experience.

Each participant will learn to play positions on offense and defense during the course of the season.

Each player has a starting position on offense and defense for games and participates in at least 50% of the games.

Teams at each grade level are formed with equal distribution of talent. There are no "All Star" or Traveling" teams.

Each player is taught leadership, football skills, rules, strategy, and discipline.

Our Coaches encourage good sportsmanship, self-confidence and teamwork.

We need 60 quality coaches to make WAA Flag Football a great experience for our 1st and 2nd Graders. WAA Football will provide you the training, materials and organizational tools to be an effective coach in a positive youth sports culture. Interested coaches are expected to attend the **sport specific training at the Woodbury Sr. High School (go to the Cafeteria Doors)**. All coaches who want to head coach MUST attend this Clinic. All prospective Flag Coaches are welcome to attend one of the June Tackle Clinics. The **non-sport specific** training as noted in the article above is a pre-requisite to the **sport specific clinic** being offered on August 7^h from 7:00 to 9:00pm at the Woodbury High School cafeteria.
