IT IS TIME TO REGISTER FOR SPRING SPORTS. In fact, starting March 1 twenty dollar late fee goes into affect. Sports are filling up; don't take a chance that your child may not be placed on a team. Register TODAY!

The registration process goes something like this: January 24, Spring registrations begin, March 1, registrations go into the Late Registration mode. On March 1, the Directors of each sport pull the numbers from the system and establish the basis for the up coming season. To get team rosters ready to start the season on time, they must get started.

For example if there are 230 1<sup>st</sup> grade boys registered for Baseball that would allow for 20 teams based on 12 children per team, there would be ten teams with 12 members and 10 with 11 members leaving openings for 10 more registrations, we would then take registrations and add the children to the teams that have only 11 until all teams have 12, when that threshold is reached the program would be closed to registration. The reasoning behind the March 1 date is so that the sport boards can formulate their teams and leagues to formally request fields from the City. The six weeks between March 1 and April 15, are extremely busy for the volunteers and adding new teams after this point is highly unlikely.

All of our Spring Sport Board of Directors work very hard to accommodate all of our members that wish to have their children placed on a team. These folks work diligently to make sure that everyone receives notice of the registration process and we ex-

haust all efforts to make sure all of you are well informed of the registration process. If there are cracks in the notification system that you see, and if you have a suggestion as to how to improve the communication process, please feel free to let me know. We are always looking for ways to improve on the communications with our members.

Coaching in WAA is a fun and rewarding way to take part in your child's development and growth in the athletic arena. WAA takes the coaching side of sports very seriously. WAA has an established procedure for the selection and certification of all coaches. When a someone applies to be a coach in WAA, they are be given a consent form that allows us to complete a back ground check , insuring that we are allowing only reputable people coach our children. Coaches need to complete a certification process that includes a 4 hour sport neutral class and a sport specific class put on by the individual sport. The sport neutral classes are provided by WAA and the records of that class are kept here for verification.

The course that we teach is a nationally recognized class sponsored by ASEP, the American Sport Education Program. The course is very comprehensive and provides for three years of certification. After that time you will be required to take a refresher course. Please check the Website for up coming classes and be sure to attend one before the start of your season. It is a great opportunity for all coaches.

WAA is in the process of changing our Website,

very soon, you will see a new and updated look to our web site and we hope to make navigation of the site much friendlier and we hope to be able to keep the information more up to date.

The upcoming opening of East Ridge High School and the formation of the East Ridge Athletic Association is still a hot topic around here, many of our sport programs are in discussions with the folks that are setting up that organization and we hope to be able to work out details that will allow for the smooth transition into the future without negative impact on the children of Woodbury.

The Woodbury Athletic Association is here to provide Athletic opportunity for all of the children of Woodbury no matter where they will attend High School. WAA is where kids can play.

Once again this year, we are offering a full range of programs starting with Pre-K (must be born before 9/1/2004) through seniors in high school. The focus of our program is on developing baseball skills and we're open to players of all skill levels. Every player that registers to play in-house baseball receives a top-quality uniform (hat, jersey, pants) and in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and above, we also provide baseball socks and a belt. In addition, each team is issued high quality, age-appropriate equipment (bats, batting helmets, catcher's gear, etc.). All you need to provide is your fielding glove!

WAA Track Program's mission is to enhance the skills of young runners and introduce them to the sport of Track & Field. The club has a goal of developing each person's leadership potential both on and off the track and field. The club is looking for kids who enjoy competing and have some interest in, track and field or just running to enhance their overall fitness.

### *Practice*

Practices will be held twice a week for one hour (in the past practices have taken place on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:00 to 7:00 P.M. The season will start in May and run into July as determined by the state meet date for 2009. The practice format provides flexibility for athletes that participate in other sports (i.e. soccer, softball, baseball) or activities (i.e., gymnastics or dance) that coincide with our season. The club asks that you attend all practices that you are able to but does not require attendance at every practice. Also families and athletes often have vacations or other plans that occur during the spring. The club attempts to keep our focus on sport in perspective, recognizing that family comes first.

### *Competition*

Prior to the start of the track & field season, each

participant will receive a “welcome” letter on-line, (or hard copy if requested) that outlines all of the available meets for us. Participants pick which meets they will attend, and participate in as many, or as few meets as they choose.

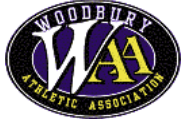

# VOLLEYBALL

## What is the Woodbury Volleyball program?

The WAA volleyball program consists of three opportunities for girls to participate in the sport of volleyball. As this is being written there are 9 teams playing in the winter traveling or as it is more commonly known the **JO volleyball** season. This year the program was able to have all girls who wanted to play volleyball participate on a team. The competitive season is for those girls who want to play at a higher level, practice more often and play for a longer season.

The next opportunity that WAA Volleyball will offer is the WAA/ Woodbury High School **summer camp**. The tentative date for this summer's camp is the first week in August. This camp has been run by M1 Volleyball coaches and assisted by Woodbury High School varsity players. The camp is open to girls who will be in grades 3-10 during the 2009-2010 school years. This is a great opportunity for young girls to learn the basics of the game and for those girls going into High School to get ready for the High School tryouts. Information regarding the camp should be out in the May newsletter, with registration starting the beginning of May.

The third opportunity is the **fall rec league**. This is a shorter season, with in house games on Saturday. The season starts the beginning of September and ends the beginning of November. The rec league is open to girls in grades 3-6 in the fall of 2009 school year. Girls in grades 7 and 8 can sign up to take part in a fall clinic. This is an opportunity to improve basic skill and get ready for the winter traveling season. WAA does not offer a fall rec league as the Junior Highs and Community Education departments run volleyball teams for girls that age through school.

## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY—DIRECTOR

The WAA Board has an opening for a fall rec league director. This position will be responsible

for running the fall rec league, including team formation, scheduling and running the Saturday league. The person who takes this position will receive fall volleyball league fees waived and a reduction in any winter fees or summer camp fees.

# WRESTLING

The youth wrestling program is in its final weeks of competition for the 2008 – 2009 season. Similar to last year, we had the boys grouped into an in-house program and a traveling program. The in-house wrestlers continued to improve their wrestling skills and showed them off at an exhibition match during one of the Woodbury High School dual meets. The goal of our in-house program is to introduce wrestling to the boys and to position them for a successful transition to the traveling program. We are pleased that several boys have expressed an interest to move to the traveling program next season.

The traveling program has built upon the momentum created last year and has had an amazing season. During the season the team participated in (or still plans to participate in) at least four team tournaments and numerous individual tournaments, including two major statewide competitions. The team took 2<sup>nd</sup> place at the Lakeville Duals in January. In February the wrestlers participated in the MYAS Gopher State tournament and we had ten place winners out of twelve participants. The MNUSA State Tournament occurs in mid-March and 12 wrestlers have already qualified for the event.

The traveling team hosted a very rewarding event on Sunday January 18th. This event was the first tournament hosted by the WAA wrestling team and was called the Royal Rumble. Eight teams from around the area participated in the tournament. Many thanks to the families who donated concession items, folks who work the tables, and the high wrestlers and

coaches who helped out tremendously. Special thanks to the Eischens family who orchestrated the finer details of the event.

In March, we will be having our recognition banquet, closing down the folk style program, and starting up a Freestyle/Greco Roman wrestling program which allows interested wrestlers to continue to wrestle throughout the spring. **ALL Registrations for WAA Sports are done online.** If you do not have access, WAA has a computer available at the WAA office M-F 2-6pm.

Once you are on the registration website, **verify your household information** and your family member data. This can be accessed via the My Account menu item on the left side of the registration web site. Then click "Shop" to get your children signed up.

**If you are new to the area or your child has never registered for a WAA sport:** You can access the registration website now to begin the process of getting your household number!
