

Bellevue Soccer Club Minutes
August 14, 2008

Called to order at 7:23 PM

July minutes were read and approved.

The following reports were given verbally:

Treasurers:

- Approximately \$12,000 liquid cash in account. Uniform bill will be coming for over \$13,000.00. The registrar does have registration fees to turn in for deposit.

Registrars: (Given by Sharon Moore)

- We have 19 select/ENSA teams this season and only 43 recreational teams. Some of the u12 boys teams will need to be combined.

Old Business:

- Marvin has sent letters to some of the vendors advising them that the only persons allowed to charge in the name of Bellevue Soccer Club are Doug Whitfield, Steve Moore and himself (Marvin Campbell). Bill Brickman advised that he needs to be added as he orders the flags and balls for the club.
- Contract for the uniforms will be honored this year and the uniforms have been ordered.
- Select Improvement Committee Report was not available.

New Business:

- Rick Reed was present and reported that the Right Foot Soccer Camp will be August 26-28, 2008. The cost is \$30.00 per player and they will receive a free T-Shirt. Camp is designed for recreational players, u12 and below. Fliers will be passed out at the coaches meeting and the Registrar (Kris) will email information out. Dennis has a curriculum format designed. Players will be grouped by age and skill.
- Photo Packages were presented by Dave Christie and Michelle Rigley. Motion made and passed to provide both photo options.

- Kris Zendejas has asked (thru Sharon) that she also get paid for the Registrar position. If paid she will give up her voting rights on the board.
- Kris will not accept request for player passes with less than 5 days notice. She will accept calls from 8 AM to 8PM only.
- Sharon read complaints from two parents regarding Dennis Beckman. One about his language toward the parent around children and another about the training the players are receiving. Todd Smith will address the language issue and Doug will address the training.
- Tim Will arrived after the discussion about complaints about Dennis and was advised that he should express his concerns to his coach. The coach can speak to Dennis directly or report it to the Director of Coaching (Steve) and Steve can report to the board and/or address Dennis. Mr. Will was advised that this instance will be addressed with Dennis by a board member.
- Bob asked for a definition of training and agreement was made that training:
 - MUST use an approved trainer that has been approved by Steve (payment will not be made unless trainer is on the approved trainer list)
 - Be conducted in the training area (some exception may be made by the field scheduler in advance)
 - Tactical and technical guidance will be given.
 - A scrimmage that lasts the entire training session is not training
- Doug also provided the training schedule that Dennis designed showing dates, times and training subjects.
- Bill advised that there is water damage in the shed, not sure the extent. The uniforms should be in this week and help is needed to sort and bag balls and uniforms. Greg will be at the club at 10:00 to complete the micro bags.
