

CCHA – Mite/8U/6U Program Refund Policy

The goal of the CCHA is to encourage as much participation at the Mite level as possible. To do so we will allow children interested in playing the opportunity to partake with the following refund policy in place if the family chooses to withdraw the child. First and foremost any families questioning the interest of their son or daughter must adhere to all registration dates and follow the payment schedule. This includes being paid in full prior to the Evaluation Day. Upon completing evaluations the child will have the opportunity to skate in all leveled practices for two weeks from the date of the evaluation, if the family chooses to withdraw during this two week period, 90% of the total fees will be refunded. The CCHA will NOT buy back any of the Gold Cards within this two week period or any time thereafter. If a family chooses to withdraw a child at any point after the two week period, they will forfeit all fees and fundraiser-based monies.

If you are choosing to withdraw your child from the CCHA Mite Program you must formally submit a request as follows: you will need to e-mail the accountant@chaskahockey.org as well as copy the commissioner of your child's program level requesting withdrawal from the program. Please include your child's name, level, and reason for withdrawal. This e-mail must be sent and received within two weeks from the date of evaluations. For example, if evaluations are on a Saturday, the last day to withdraw for a refund would be two Saturdays following.
