

Team Managers,

Congratulations on your acceptance to the 2011 Palatine Celtic Cup. You will be joining almost 400 other teams in Palatine for Labor Day Weekend. We look forward to hosting you.

The information below details what we need from your team. We require you to submit all documents prior to your arrival at final registration. This enables us to only check player passes and add any information that may have changed since your forms were submitted.

These are the additional registration requirements for the Palatine Celtic Cup. I need all of your documents no later than Monday, August 29.

If you are an IYSA affiliated team we only need:

1. the attached file or the Gotsoccer IYSA tournament roster,
2. Your state approved roster.
3. Please do not send medical release forms. You are required to have them at all games, but we are no longer required to check them or to keep them.

If you are an out of state team that is affiliated with the USYSA, we need:

1. the attached file or the Gotsoccer IYSA tournament roster,
2. your state approved roster,
3. Illinois medical release forms for all players
4. travel permit

If you are a US Club team, whether in Illinois or out of Illinois we need:

1. IYSA Tournament roster (linked below) or the Gotsoccer IYSA tournament roster,
2. your state approved roster,
3. Illinois medical release forms for all players
4. Form NT

Any teams that are going to be using guest players—If the players are from within your club, they are not considered guest players. You can just add them to the end of the IYSA tournament roster. If you cannot access the Illinois guest player form and you are from outside of Illinois, you may use your own states form.

Several teams have reported to me that they are having trouble with the IYSA tournament roster that is on Gotsoccer. The link below is an excel file that replaces that form. If you have not gone on Gotsoccer yet and that form you can substitute this one.
