A Board of Directors runs the Vacationland Skating Club, with many committees doing various duties. It is a non-profit, mostly volunteer club. We are asking all parents/guardians to become active in helping a great club become better. Without this support the club cannot operate. VFSC has a Mandatory Family Service program.

- **Each Basic Skills family** will be required to work ten (10) hours throughout the season with half of these hours being met by February 1, 2010, and the other half of the hours to be fulfilled during show week. All families are expected to help in some capacity during show week, regardless of previously fulfilled Mandatory Family Service Hours. These are not limited to just show week, but must be in the capacity of a show project. Hours will be required regardless of previously fulfilling the Mandatory Family Service Hours earlier in the year.
- **Each Junior or Senior Club family** will be required to work at least 15 hours throughout the season, with half of these hours being met by February 1, 2010, and the other 7 1/2 hours to be fulfilled during show week. All families are expected to help in some capacity during show week, regardless of previously fulfilled Mandatory Family Service Hours. These are not limited to just show week, but must be in the capacity of a show project. Hours will be required regardless of previously fulfilling the Mandatory Family Service Hours earlier in the year.
