

# LET'S PLAY HOCKEY!

The Calumet Hockey Association is having its registration on Saturday, September 20<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm at the Calumet Colosseum. There will also be a second session on Tuesday, September 23rd from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM, again at the Calumet Colosseum.

All participants must register on-line at [usahockeyregistration.com](http://usahockeyregistration.com) before attending registration. You will be required to pay a \$35 fee to USA Hockey via credit card and then print off a bar-coded IMR (Individual Membership Registration form). If you do not have access to the internet, we will be able to process some requests at the Colosseum at the time of registration.

## Program Fees

All registration fees listed below include the purchase of \$50 raffle tickets and \$21 Hockey Weekend Roast Beef Dinner tickets which participant may sell and keep the money. For example, a Squirt registration fee of \$355 can be reduced by selling \$50 of raffle tickets and \$21 of dinner tickets for a net cost of \$284. Raffle tickets are distributed at registration. Dinner tickets are distributed later in the season.
