

DYHA Refund Policy

1. No refund will be made of the \$100 fundraiser fee due at registration after October 15.
2. Refunds may be requested for the Learn to Skate Program up to 7 days prior to the beginning of the Program. Requests for refunds must be made in writing to the DYHA Board of Directors. If written request is not received 7 days prior to the start of the program, the player will be considered active with all dues and fees payable in full. No refunds will be made after the start of the Learn to Skate program
3. No refund will be made to members for the USA Hockey registration fees.
4. No refund will be made for advertisements and/or sponsorships paid by members in excess of the annual fees incurred by the member.
5. No refund will be made for advertisement or business sponsorship monies collected and submitted by members to offset dues or as donations to DYHA.
6. No refund will be made to members who are suspended by USA Hockey, DYHA, Dane County League, Midwest League, or any other hockey league affiliation.
7. House League Fees: If a player is injured for the remainder of the season, relocates, or chooses not to play for the remainder of the season and has paid more than the above non-refundable fees, a refund will be made based on the following schedule:

If Refund is Requested:	Amount Refunded:
before September 15	100% of Refundable fee + Fundraiser Fee
before October 15	75% of Refundable Fee + Fundraiser Fee
before November 15	50% of Refundable Fee
before December 15	25% of Refundable Fee
on or after December 15	No-Refund

The effective date of resignation shall be the date the DYHA Board of Directors receives written notice of such resignation. Written Notice must be received within 30 days of the season ending injury or relocation. If no written notice of resignation is received, the player will be considered active with all dues and fees payable in full.

8. Travel Team Fees: If a player is injured for the remainder of the season or relocates, and has paid more than the above non-refundable fees, a refund will be made in the amount equal to the pro-rated fee times the number of weeks remaining in the season. The effective date of resignation shall be the date the DYHA Board of Directors receives written notice of such resignation. Written Notice must be received within 30 days of the season ending injury or relocation. If no written notice of resignation is received, the player will be considered active with all dues and fees payable in full.
9. Exceptions to this refund policy may be granted under extraordinary circumstances. For an exception to be considered, it must be made in writing and be brought to the Board of Directors for consideration.
