### All Parents League Players Must Read and Sign This Form

The Parents League is a coed, recreational, and instructional (for players, referees, and linesmen) league intended primarily for parents and friends of the White Bear Soccer Club. It is intended for those with limited or no playing experience. If you've recently played high school or college soccer, this league is not for you. A Minnesota Soccer Association (MSA) competitive league is probably more appropriate for your skill level.

You assume all risk of injury and are responsible for your own medical insurance. To play in the Parents League you must wear shin guards and no jewelry please.

I, agree and understand that once this registration form is submitted, and accepted to WBSC and White Bear Community Services and Recreation (WBCSR), (1) grant WBSC the right to use and publish pictures containing the registrant, (2) agree to not sue WBSC, WBSC board member, or WBCSR. Recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with soccer and in consideration for the WBSC and WBCSR accepting me for its soccer programs and activities, I hereby release, discharge and/or otherwise indemnify the WBSC and WBCSR, its affiliated organizations and sponsors, their employees and associated personnel, including the owners of fields and facilities utilized for the programs, against any claim by or on behalf of the registrant as a result of the registrant's participation in the program and/or being transported to or from the same, which transportation I hereby authorize.

Games are 7 v 7 for 50 minutes (two 25 minute halves) and are played on Sunday evenings on Under-10 fields. Standard soccer rules are enforced with three exceptions : 1) there is a limit of one goal per person per game; 2) each team must have at least two (2) women on the field at all times. The season runs from June through September. 3.) This is a "non-contact league". Consistent physical play may lead to suspension from a game or the season.
