



Gymnasium and School Building Usage Guidelines for Indoor Soccer

Please read and follow these policies and procedures

Arrival Time

Do NOT arrive more than 5 minutes prior to your assigned time for all events.

Supervision

1. NBSC provides volunteer coaches and managers for all recreational teams. The coaches and managers are not in charge of the supervision of the participants. **PARENTS**, it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to supervise your child/family when in the school buildings. **Siblings should remain with their parents at all times, and NO CHILD is allowed in the hallways or commons without a parent.** Participants are expected to remain in the gyms unless an emergency such as fire, injury, etc would dictate otherwise.

2. **No one is allowed on the stages at any site.**

3. **Participants must be escorted by an adult or parent in the hallways or commons areas when they leave the gym for a drink of water.** No running in the school hallways!

Soccer Ball Usage in the Gyms

No one is allowed to play with soccer balls in any school hallway or room other than the gym. There are too many spots where damage could be done to the building. Only the **approved indoor soccer balls and futsal balls may be used during practices and games.** Participants may NOT bring their own soccer balls to indoor events. Additionally soccer players should **never punt the indoor soccer balls** during indoor practices.

Food and Drinks

All drinks including water, juice, and coffee are strictly prohibited to protect the gym floor surface and to diminish custodial clean up time. This is a requirement of the warranty on the gym floors at Reagan and Poplar Creek. Participants need to use the school drinking fountains located adjacent to the gyms.

Reagan School

Enter and exit through the main entrance of the building. Use of restrooms and drinking fountains is limited to the main hallway and commons near the front entrance.

Poplar Creek School

Enter and exit through the doors on the north side of the gym. Use of restrooms and drinking fountains is limited to those in the gym area.

Remember that NBSC is a guest in the schools. In order to continue offering an Indoor Soccer program we need to follow all of these guidelines. NBSC will pay for all damage done to the school buildings from broken ceiling tiles to damaged lights or ceiling vents. NBSC will also be charged the maintenance time to make all repairs. Please **RESPECT** the school property so we can avoid additional charges.
