Meeting called to order at 7:06 pm

- Approval of minutes from February. Geoff made a motion to approve the minutes from the February meeting with no amendments, Mike 2<sup>nd</sup> minutes approved unanimously.
- A discussion was held on a bid that was received to host the IIHF Women's National Championships. Park City is interested in supplying the rooms for the teams as well as using their rink as the practice rink.
- Finances – Scott Hinerman - nothing to report
- Goalie clinic – Update from February, Geoff recapped Jay's presentation for Mike. Geoff said he would like to see the youth council take charge of this and decide what they would do if they were given a certain amount of money. A discussion followed on how the organizations should contribute and if the board needs to purchase sticks. Jared had suggested a state wide equipment drive that would allow people to donate new or used gear to the Utah Grizzlies tax deductible and it could be stored at the E-Center and used for the Try it for Free hockey clinics and also if organizations need gear it could be available. A discussion followed on how many one goal sticks should be ordered for all the learn to play programs. Geoff said he thinks there is a need for those sticks and if \$1500.00 takes care of the need for the whole state we could buy them all and distribute to all the youth programs in the state. We think we can get enough gear for the hockey for free clinics by doing a statewide gear drive. Debbie made a motion that we purchase up to \$1500.00 worth or 1 goal sticks or equivalent from another vendor that will match or beat the price. Mike 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously. The discussion on Jay's goalie clinics resumed. Mike likes the idea of the training for the goalies. Fred said that he wouldn't mind giving some money to purchase ice a few times a year to have coaches and goalie clinics. Don said that there are other very good goalie coaches in the state that will do clinics and not charge the state anything. Geoff said that \$20K is a lot of money and it is probably not the best use of the states money. Geoff and Fred said that this kind of stuff should go through the state coaching director so Don needs to talk to Jay and come back to the board with what he thinks would benefit the state. **Action Item: Don Korth to work out a goalie clinic with Jay Stevens or other interested parties.** Mike made a motion that the board deny the request for goalie equipment due to excessive cost and have Jay work through Don Korth to come up with an alternative plan that will benefit the state, the coaches and the most goalies possible. Debbie 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed.
- Try Hockey for Free update – The Free hockey clinic was a big success with almost 60 people coming out to try it. A state wide equipment drive will be held to get gear that can be stored at the E-center and used for future clinics. Geoff had to scramble to get

equipment but we ended up with enough for everyone who came out to try. Geoff said for future clinics we need a local program person to be in attendance so that as people are leaving there is someone who can give them information. Geoff said that since this was plugged as a state event we need to have people from the various sub-affiliates come out and help especially from the local programs where the people will play.

- A discussion followed on conflicting events and what people should do when they can't make the meetings or state sanctioned events. Fred said that each organization needs to send a representative to all events or board meetings if they can't make it.
- Adult League Eligibility – Fred said there was a conversation at nationals and we cannot roster any minors on any adult league team per USA Hockey. Geoff made a motion that every organization or team in the state must send their rosters through the Utah State or District Registrar or as directed by UAHA. Mike 2<sup>nd</sup> passed unanimously.
- Adult Tournament/Adult League – Neither Wade or Matt were at the meeting. Fred mentioned that last month there was a motion and vote that Matt and Wade e required to have financials from the adult Winterfest tournament available at the March board meeting. See Matt's e-mail response regarding the availability of the financials. Fred said that the tournament made money, and the state paid for 2 sets of jerseys that are not being used. Fred said he also thinks that Matt got paid to schedule all the games because they did not use the Salt Lake scheduler for refs, Matt scheduled them, and Theresa Bateman was also paid to keep score at the event. The ice bill from Steiner has not yet been paid. Geoff said he had conversation with Wade today and he is frustrated with things right now and is thinking about having the Adult League to go ISI instead of USA Hockey for the next year. Wade said that he has taken care of all the parts that he is responsible for and is waiting for Matt to take care of his numbers and to submit the final receipts and expenditures. Mike asked if there was a time that someone could get with them and help them get what they need to supply to the board. Geoff said that in all fairness to Wade he did call and was very frustrated. Fred said that Geoff needs to talk to Bruce and make sure he understands that the grant money needs to go to the state not to the adult league. Geoff asked what the appropriate consequence is for Matt not showing up with the finances discussion followed on this.
- Weblinks and Web Ads – Fred said we need to make sure that every sub-affiliate has a link to the state site on their web site. Web ads, HS Hockey sells web ads that went on all the HS websites and it is a link to an advertiser, Fred said we should look to pick up advertisers that will buy ads to be placed on our website. The HS gives the person selling the ad a 20% commission.
- Hanson Brothers appearance – Jared is in the process of checking with South West airlines to see if they will donate the airfare for them. The Grizzlies Childrens Charity organization will help with the cost and the state will keep the money made from the

sale of pictures that we will set up to do during all the events held that day. A photographer will be located on the concourse during the Grizzlies home game that night as well as at the clinics. Profits will need to be split between the shoot for the cure and UAHA. Fred suggested that UAHA kick in \$3500.00 and asked if Grizzlies can come up with the rest. Jared said hotel and food should be covered and the only problem is airfare to get them all here from back east. A discussion followed on how much should be charged for the pictures and how many we think there will be. There are a lot of opportunities happening that day. Jared said if the board can pitch in \$4K Grizzlies can come up with the rest. Mike asked Scott if there was any more money coming in this year. Scott said that there is money coming in but we are down at this time of year since most registrations have already been processed. Geoff made a motion that the board approve \$4000.00 to bring in the Hanson Brothers to be paid to the Utah Grizzlies. Mike 2<sup>nd</sup> passed unanimously.

- Hockey Equipment Drive – Fred and Jared talked about some kind of discount for Grizzlies tickets for bringing in equipment. Jared said they can create a coupon for \$5.00 off a ticket that they could take upstairs and redeem for a ticket to the game on the 27<sup>th</sup> or possibly the 1<sup>st</sup> playoff game. All equipment will be welcomed, put in a room at the E-Center and then the board will go through and see what can be used and what should be thrown away. USA Hockey is offering free jerseys that each sub-affiliate can apply for.
- Coaching Association – Don has had a lot of e-mails and phone calls about the coaching clinic coming up on the 27<sup>th</sup>. He has received a lot of positive feedback on this clinic. Geoff and Fred and Don are going to get together and discuss how best to run this clinic. Don is hoping to get at least 100 people at the coaching clinic. There are 2 other dates being looked at: one is during regional development camp Don or Geoff needs to talk to Tom Lampl about this to schedule something for this time to take advantage of having the USA hockey people here and the other date is end of June or middle of July to have a full day coaching seminar where speakers will be brought in from throughout the country.
- District Camp Tryouts – Peter was not at the meeting.
- College Clinic – Sandy will check on the current number of people registered and send out the numbers
- HS Playoffs/Championship update – Skyline won the state championships by a score of 7 to 6 in overtime.
- Mike said that the URL is having a tournament coming up. He would like to have the board help offset some of the cost of the tournament. He is thinking that the total tournament cost will be \$6 – 8K. He said he thinks a reasonable amount is \$1500 to 2K. The games are being played at the Provo rink. Scott said that it is kind of a

disappointment that each organization can only send 1 team to this tournament. Geoff said he thinks it needs to be an open tournament and every team that wants to participate should be allowed. Debbie made a motion that the state supports the URL with a \$2k donation to help with the URL tournament, provided that the URL committee presents the board with a financial accounting by the next board meeting. Fred 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously.

- A discussion followed on the national tournament and whether or not the state will pay the tournament entry fee for nationals. Debbie asked if there are still districts and nationals do the teams get paid for both.
- Mike asked if CVAHA could use the receipts that they have for the goalie gear they purchased to get the goalie grant. Geoff said that all proposals for grant money need to be submitted to the board by March 29<sup>th</sup>.
- Jared said that there was a Grizzlies season ticket holder that just passed away from Lou Gerigs disease and in lieu of flowers the family is asking for donations to be made to the Utah Grizzlies Childrens Charity earmarked for youth hockey.
- Jared also said that he would like to see the state board purchase season tickets for the Grizzlies game to be used as they see fit. He is thinking 4 center plaza seats at a discount at a cost of \$2448 for 4 tickets for next season. Geoff said he would also like to see us purchase a suite for 2 games during the next season. Fred likes the idea of putting a weekly trivia question on the website and having a drawing to give away the tickets. Debbie also suggested giving them to the sub-affiliates and allowing them to give them away. Mike said he thinks there is a lot of benefit to being involved with the Grizzlies organization. Geoff asked if UAHA could get a suite for the last home game Jared will check to see what is available. Geoff made a motion that the state purchase 4 season tickets to be used to support and promote youth hockey for an amount not to exceed \$2448 and 2 suites for next season. Fred 2<sup>nd</sup> passed unanimously.
