New Web Address = www.redwingathleticassociation.org

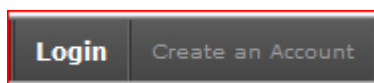
From the menu choose, “Baseball” and you will be directed to the Baseball home page.

The website will be your source for information regarding the Baseball Association and each respective baseball team. Information regarding practices, game schedules, tryout schedules, Coaches contact information, etc. will all be advertised from this site.

We ask that the parents of each player go to the website and create a login account to access the Baseball Association website (Please note: If you have a account with Hockey, Basketball, or Soccer you will NOT have to create a new account. Your account will work with the Baseball site also).

Directions for creating a account:

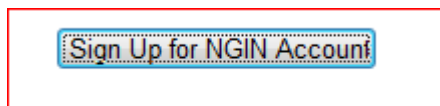

2. How do I find my son's team information?

From the menu on the left hand side click on "2010 Team Pages":

Then click on the respective team. From here you can view practice calendars, game schedules, announcements, and coaches contact information.

3. How can I view one calendar for all my son or son's activities?
 - a. Login to the Red Wing website and choose Calendars from the main menu.
