NOTE: As the NCCP moves through the transition, from Levels to Competency Based certification, coaches need to become familiar with the new terminology. By completing the “on line quiz” and attending this clinic you will be considered “trained” and are eligible to be on the bench by yourself as a first year coach.

Returning coaches must be “evaluated”, which means they have attended clinic and completed an evaluation workbook.

You will receive an email once your application has been accepted, giving you details of your online component including username and password.
