GAMES and PRACTICES

Welcome to U13 Spring/Summer Soccer season. Our goal is to advance their soccer skills, learn the rules of the game, and have fun. There will be approximately 10 to 12 league games this summer. The games will be played on Tuesday or Thursday between May 3rd and July 12th. The away games are generally played near the Twin Cities or Rochester area. We will have more details after the coaches meeting. Strength training at Sports Institute practices will cost \$90.00 for 10 sessions. This is **Optional**. You can do individual sessions for \$10.00. Sports Institute practice is Sunday (5:30 to 6:20 pm) and Friday (6:00 to 7:00 pm). The first Sports Institute practice is Sunday, February 28th. We will start practice the week of April 5th. Practice will be located at Buscher Park on April 6th (Tuesday) starting at 6:30 pm and ending at 8:00 pm. We will have practice Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday. The practices on Tuesday may change from week to week due to school commitments.

4. Soccer cleats
5. One extra pair of white socks
6. Bring Game uniforms to **all games**
7. Please watch the weather and have your child dressed appropriately. He may need to bring a jacket, wind pants, gloves, turtleneck, cap, sunscreen, umbrella, etc. Extra clothing can go under the jerseys. When playing a game, no clothing can be worn outside the jersey.
