

# Parent Responsibility Sheet

- Let's remember that we're all here for fun. This is not the pro's. All officials, coaches, players and spectators need to be treated in a courteous, respectful manner.
- Shin pads are mandatory. Soccer cleats are recommended for grades K-2 and are mandatory for grades 3-8.
- Always bring a water bottle for your child. No water is available at the fields.
- Only praise and applauding the teams is accepted at games. At the K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade level there is no score tallied. Everyone wins!
- Keep the soccer field site clean. Be sure to clean up after yourself before leaving.
- **There is NO SMOKING at game sites.**
- **Pets are not allowed at the soccer field sites. Please leave dogs at home.**
- Bring any concerns or comments to your coach in a reasonable manner – while the children are not listening.
- Car-pooling is fine, but remember you need to care for all the children within your car pool. One parent needs to stay at the game. If you need to leave, make arrangements with another parent to look after your child and let your child know who that person is. **Coaches are here to coach...not baby-sit.**
- Always call the coach ASAP if your child cannot attend a game. We realize illness and vacations arise, but if your child is not present their team will have to play short. Please give the coaches as much notice as possible.
- Be on time for practices and games. Come 10 minutes early. You let the team down by not being there on time. It also makes it difficult for the coach to shuffle the positions of the players as many of the coaches determine the player positions before getting to the fields.
- You will have one or two games designated when you need to bring fruit and a drink for the entire team. If you cannot attend that game please switch nights with another parent. The kids notice when the treats are forgotten.
- No jewelry can be worn during play. **Pierced earrings must be removed.** Children who wear glasses need to have a strap attached to their glasses.
