SNSA Club Player Dual-Registration Policy

A team from the SNSA competitive program may submit a written petition to the Competitive Program Director for permission to register a player that is registered and currently playing with an SNSA recreational league team. If the petition receives the approval of the CPD, it will be forwarded to the League Registrar. If approved by the League Registrar, said player will be granted temporary dual-registration and will be allowed to play for both his or her SNSA recreational team and his or her SNSA competitive club team for the remainder of the current recreational season, including the league tournament. Once the recreational season is concluded, the player will be limited to playing with his or her SNSA competitive club team, and will not be allowed to play in an SNSA recreational league unless the player submits a release form signed by the club coach.

Temporary dual-registration may only be granted at the discretion of the Competitive Program Director and League Registrar to players that register with an SNSA club team. A player that registers with another club team during the recreational season will not be granted dual-registration, and will be removed from his or her SNSA recreational team. Players that are registered with any club team, including an SNSA club team, at the start of the recreational season will not be granted dual-registration status, and must decide whether to play for the recreational team or the competitive club team. Refunds will not be issued for players that leave SNSA recreational teams to play for club teams.

It is expected that cases of dual registration will be limited to circumstances in which an SNSA competitive team roster level falls below an acceptable level to operate a competitive club team; a player in the SNSA recreational league that clearly plays at a higher competitive level is identified by SNSA staff; or other limited circumstances that justify allowing a player to play for both an SNSA competitive team and an SNSA recreational team. If the Competitive Program Director and League Registrar cannot come to an agreement whether or not to allow dual-registration for a player, the decision shall be deferred to the SNSA Board of Directors.
