



## LISC Coaches Code of Conduct

- As a coach within LISC, I will behave in a professional manner and use self control. The principles of good sportsmanship and fair play will be emphasized and demonstrated at all times by the coaching staff.
- I will refrain from the use of profanity at soccer practice/games so that I can be an example to the children for whom I'm coaching.
- I will enforce the "24 hour rule" as outlined in the LISC policy manual when dealing with parents/players within the club.
- I will communicate regularly with the LISC DOC if there are team problems or if I can't live up to my responsibilities as a coach within the club. I will notify the DOC prior to tryouts for the next yr. if I cannot coach the following yr.
- I will make an effort to read the LISC coaches manual/curriculum/LISC policy manual so that I am well equipped with the knowledge needed in coaching a team within LISC. I will also make an effort to better my coaching education if approached by the DOC for an upcoming course(s).
- I will agree to meet with the LISC DOC at the end of each season (fall/spring) and also provide the DOC with the material needed for the meeting which would be: LISC post game analysis, practice plans, individual player evaluation, and tryout/team player evaluation.
- I will treat the LISC parents with respect when dealing with playing time issues/concerns and will be approachable as long as the LISC "24 hour rule" has been established.
- I will attempt to wear LISC gear at all training/games to distinguish myself from parents/observers and will be on time to all training/games.
- It is up to the discretion of the DOC if anything mentioned above will cause suspension/dismissal from LISC. The Coaches Code of Conduct is merely a tool for our coaching staff to have a set list of expectations as we progress as a club for the future.
