

BSC Summer HS 9v9 Soccer League Rules

1. Games played in accordance with FIFA Laws except for modifications of the laws as mentioned below.
2. Teams shall consist of 9 players
3. Team must field 6 registered players at game time for a match to begin. There is a 10 minute grace period. A team that can not field the minimum number of players forfeits the game.
4. Games shall be two 25 Minute halves and a 3-minute break for half-time.
5. **No** slide tackling. Except for keepers gaining possession of the ball.
6. There will be **NO** offside position or infraction in games.
7. **After Gaining possession of the ball, the Goal Keeper may not Throw, kick, or punt the ball across the mid field line in the air without it touching the ground or another player first. Penalty will be an Indirect free kick for the opposing team at the mid field line.**
 - a. **If The Goal Keeper places the ball in play and dribbles outside the penalty area, they may subsequently kick the ball across mid-field in the air. However, as soon as the keeper places in in play, they may be fairly charged by an opponent.**
 - b. **This rule also applies to goal kicks taken by ANY player. If the Goal Keeper dribbles the ball outside the penalty area**
8. Substitutions may be made during **any** stoppage of play provided an unfair advantage is not taken by the offending team during corner kicks, throw-ins, free kicks, or penalty kicks.
9. Teams are allowed to roster 14 primary players.
10. All players shall either be registered with BSC or must sign a waiver of liability prior to playing. Only players listed on the official team roster may play. The roster must be turned into the League Coordinator(s) prior to the first week. . Any teams playing or attempting to play with players not Properly registered or with red-carded players will be subject to a forfeit in that game.
11. All other laws will be IAW FIFA laws of the game including Fouls and Misconduct, start/restarts, etc.
12. Decisions of the referee concerning the game are final and may **NOT** be protested.
