



**Welcome to the Breezy Point Acceleration Hockey Academy,**

You are registered for the July 11-16<sup>th</sup> Camp. Please review the camp information below and if you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact us. Below you should find all the information you need to get ready for camp. **Player Behavior:** Before arriving to camp we ask that parents please have a serious discussion with their players about respecting other players, coaches, counselors, and employees of Breezy Point Arena and Resort. It is our intent to make sure that every player has a fun and enjoyable experience while at Camp. Players that tease, make fun of other players, bully others in any way, or fight with others will be sent home without a refund. "I was just joking or kidding" is not an acceptable excuse so please make sure that your players understand this before arriving to camp.

**Check- In Times:** Sundays 7/11/ 3:00pm – 4:00pm

All players should be checked into camp no later than 4:00pm. Our camp meeting for the campers will take place at 4:00pm so please try to arrive prior to 3:30pm to allow time for the check in process. Dinner will be served for all campers at 5:00pm.

**Check-In Location:** Check-in is Sunday at the Breezy Point Arena Dormitory next the Breezy Point Ice Arena located at 7370 County Rd 11 just 1 mile west of the gate and main entrance to Breezy Point Resort or 3 miles east of Minnesota Hwy 371. From Hwy 371 In downtown Pequot Lakes head east on County Rd 11 (the only stoplight in Pequot), the Arena and Dormitory are located approximately 3 miles from Hwy 371 on the north side of County Rd 11.

**What to Bring:**

**Waiver of Liability & Consent to Treat:** If you have not completed and signed the waiver of liability and consent to treat portion of the registration brochure please download a registration form/brochure from our website at [www.breezypointsports.com](http://www.breezypointsports.com) and bring it with you to check in. All players must have these forms on file to be at camp.

**Clothing:** Campers should bring plenty of clothing for all types of weather. T-shirts, sweatshirts, jeans, shorts, sweatpants, socks, underwear, swim suit, beach towel, and at least two pairs of tennis shoes. Sorry but there are no laundry facilities on site so bring plenty of clothing for hockey time, dry land acceleration training, lounging, and off site activities in and out of the water.

**Toiletries:** Campers will need toothpaste, tooth brush, washcloth, towels, deodorant and any other items they feel they will need etc. The dorms do have all purpose soap/shampoo in the showers but some players choose to bring their own. Players are required to shower daily. Players should also pack sun screen and insect repellent.

**Bedding:** Campers should bring sheets, blankets, pillows, and or sleeping bags. The dormitory is air conditioned but some sections do get colder or hotter than others so an extra blanket and a small fan may be helpful as well.

**Hockey Equipment:** All players are required to bring all of their protective hockey equipment including mouth pieces. Please bring an old stick for outdoor dry land shooting. If you need any equipment for camp we do have a full service Pro Shop with everything except for skates.

**Spending Money:** A camp bank is available for players to keep their spending money in while at camp. All regular meals, lodging, ice time, and in-house camp activities are included in the registration fees. However items such as concessions, skate sharpening, pro shop purchases, and off site vacationland activities are not included. An average player will usually go through \$75 - \$125 during the week.

**Personal Electronics:** We do not recommend players bringing expensive electronic devices or phones. Dormitory rooms are not locked and items can be easily lost, misplaced, or stolen. Breezy Point is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen personal items.

**Snacks/Drinks:** Resident campers receive 3 well rounded meals per day, any special needs or dietary considerations should be communicated to the camp administrator before your arrival at camp. Campers are allowed to bring their own snacks for the evenings as most get hungry before bed, the concession stand is open until 9:00pm each evening as well. Please do not send sunflower seeds, nuts, popcorn, or other messy snacks that will most likely get spilled in the rooms and attract ants etc.

**Dorm & Resort Activities:** During the week there will be lots of other activities between ice time and training. There will be time for players to golf if they choose to so bring golf clubs if you want to golf. The cost for golf is 10.00+ tax. Other items you may choose to bring if you have them are tennis rackets, swimming trunks and a beach towel. There will be movie times in the dorms so if you want to bring your favorite movie we may watch it. No R rated movies please, just PG13 and below.

**Vacationland Activities:** During the week we provide each group two different opportunities to take part in popular vacationland activities providing that the weather cooperates. These activities do cost extra and are not mandatory. Players may choose between a vacationland activity or stay at the dormitory facility to relax or take part in dormitory activities.

**Go Carting & Mini Golf:** Weather permitting we take the players down to Pirates Cove Mini Golf and Billy Bones Go Cart Track in Brainerd.

Mini Golf = 6.95 for 18 holes

Go Cart = \$7.50 for 1 Race

Combo = 12:95 for 18 holes and 1 Race

**Go Cart Mini Golf Weather Alternative – Water Park:** If the weather does not allow us to Mini Golf and Go Cart we will go to an indoor water park in Brainerd. The cost is \$9.95 + Tax.

**Horseback Riding & Wild West Stunt Show:** The other vacationland activity weather permitting is horseback riding at the Pine River Riding Stables and a Wild West Stunt Show.

Trail Ride = \$18.00 per person

Wild West Stunt Show = \$8.00 per person

Trail Ride & Wild West Stunt Show = \$25.00

**Horseback Riding Weather Alternative – Bowling/Movie:** If the weather does not cooperate for horseback riding we will go bowling or to a movie.

Movie = \$6.50 per person + concessions

Bowling = \$3.00 per game + \$2.00 shoe rental

**Golf:** Players who do not wish to go Go-Carting or Horseback Riding may choose to play golf at the Traditional Golf Course at Breezy Point Resort.

Traditional Golf = \$9.95 plus tax.

**Check-Out Time:** Friday 4:30pm-5:00pm, Parents are asked to arrive at the Dorms between 4:30pm and 5:00pm on Friday to pick up their players. On Friday afternoon we have scheduled a fun new farewell event for the kids before leaving. We will be taking all of the players down to Breezy Point Resort for a farewell cruise on Breezy Point's new Paddle Boat the Breezy Belle. We will be taking them out to Gooseberry Island on Pelican Lake for a farewell cookout and beach activities.
