

Registration for the upcoming Everest Youth Hockey season is now open!

Please be sure to register by September 1<sup>st</sup> to take advantage of a \$50 per skater discount. All registration fees for the upcoming season remained unchanged. As like last year, only on-line registrations will be accepted and every skater needs to first register with USA Hockey. The only significant change to the process is how we handle the High School eligible Bantams who will skate with EYH during October and the first part of November until they go through the High School try-out process (covered below)

Some questions that came up during last season's registration process:

Why do I need to register twice?

With the introduction of online registration EYH is no longer responsible for registering your son/daughter with USA Hockey and its affiliates (WAHA). You need to register with USA Hockey before you register with EYH. When you register, your first step will be to register with USA hockey. Upon completion of this step you will receive a confirmation code that you will need when you go to register with EYH. The cost for USA hockey is \$40. In the past EYH would include this \$40 in their registration fee and be responsible for registering your skater with USA hockey and forwarding on payment. To compensate for this, beginning last year, EYH lowered their fees by \$40.

So how do I register?

Once you register with USA hockey take the confirmation code you receive and begin the registration process with EYH off of our website. This is something that each of you need to do individually as you will not only enter your demographics but you will also select your fundraising activities and volunteer options. Many of you already have a login and password for our site but if you are new to the organization, one is required. The website will be one of the primary means of communication throughout the year so it will become evident that a login and password is a good idea.

My son is a Bantam and may make the JV team, do I need to register?

Yes, if he wants to practice before the High School team is decided upon. Bantam practices are tentatively scheduled to start in early October and your skater will have approximately 20 hours of practice in before the HS team is decided. The best way to get some ice time is to register your skater with US Hockey and EYH.

Do I have to pay the USA hockey fee?

To skate with EYH in any capacity (games or practices) you must register and you must have the USA hockey confirmation code. The USA hockey, among many other benefits includes insurance coverage that EYH benefits from.

Is it free for first year mini mite skaters?

Yes!. There is no charge for first year mini mite skaters. If your child is 7yrs old or above, you will be required to pay the \$40 USA hockey fee which we will reimburse once the season begins. For first year skaters at other levels you will be charged 50% of the standard registration fee. You will also need to pay the USA hockey fee.

I have more than one of my children skating. Do I need to pay more than once for fundraisers?

No, fundraisers are on a per family basis. If you are signing multiple kids up you should handle their fundraising on one of the kids only and then select pay later for all the other kids. Then they will be changed once.

Registration must be paid in full or no jerseys will be handed out at the parent meeting!
