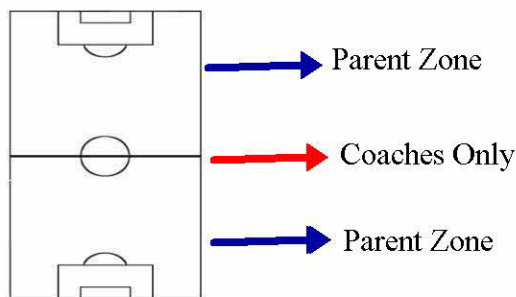




PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will respect the game of soccer and its laws. I will learn the laws for my child's age group and try to understand them.
- I will show respect for the referees and not openly question their judgment. I understand they call the game to the best of their ability.
- I will not harass, yell, or agitate a referee before, during or after a game.
- I will not shout instructions or coach my child or any other player during a game.
- I will accept the outcome of the game and show good sportsmanship before, during and after games toward opposing teams, coaches, and referees.
- I will represent myself, my child's team and my child's club with dignity, pride and an example of good sportsmanship.
- I will not badger, ridicule, or taunt players from my team or the opposing team. They are ALL children and they ALL have feelings and it WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- I will show respect for the Heat FC staff which includes coaches, trainers, managers, and administrators.
- I will not talk negatively or hurtful about players, coaches, or parents within the Heat FC Club. I will contact a Heat Administrator if problems arise.
- I will not interfere with a Coach during a game or practice. If a problem arises I will abide by the 24-hour "cooling-off" period before contacting the coach in any way (email, phone, or in person) to discuss this issue. ZERO tolerance and NO EXCEPTIONS.
- I understand that the commitment to Heat FC lies mainly on the parents and it is imperative to set an example of timeliness, respect, sportsmanship and integrity.
- I will see that my child follows all uniform policies for practice, games, tournaments , both local and out-of-town, and club events.
- I will help my child follow all communication policies to notify coaches regarding missed practices, games, and events.
- I will accept the responsibility and consequences of the player not following these rules which may result in loss of playing time at the coaches' discretion.
- I understand that Heat FC is a competitive club and playing time is NOT GUARANTEED.
- Parent's failure to comply may result in disciplinary actions up to and including loss of playing time or suspension from the team for your child.
