

Champlin Park Youth Hockey Association (CPYHA)
Financial Assistance Policy
(Adopted August, 2010)

1. All families requesting Financial Assistance must complete the CPYHA Financial Assistance Application. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
2. During the budgeting process, the CPYHA Board of Directors (BOD) will determine the total annual amount available for Financial Assistance. The total amount of assistance granted to CPYHA families cannot exceed the budgeted amount.
3. Financial Assistance is designed to help families through finite periods of financial hardship. It is not intended to be an annual subsidy. As such, Financial Assistance is limited to 2 years per player.
4. Preference will be given to those applicants whose families qualify for public assistance programs such as; school lunch subsidies, medical assistance, and unemployment insurance.
5. Financial Assistance is limited to CPYHA registration fees and monthly ice bills. Under no circumstance, will Financial Assistance be granted for clinics, out of town tournament expenses, equipment costs, coach's gifts, team apparel, etc...
6. Families receiving Financial Assistance will be assessed additional volunteer hours. The number of hours will be determined, documented, and monitored by the BOD.
7. Families receiving Financial Assistance will be expected to actively participate in fund raising opportunities (ex. Holiday wreath sales) to help alleviate the financial burden on themselves and the CPYHA.
8. Financial Assistance applicants will be required to meet with at least 2 members of the BOD to review their application and the circumstances involved with requesting aid.
9. Financial Assistance is provided at the sole discretion of the CPYHA BOD.
