## **HOCKEY –**

### **Fall/Pre-Season Tournament Hockey:**

- Two Tournaments – Early Bird played locally in Denver September 22, 23 24<sup>th</sup>. and the Vail Tournaments played in Vail the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend in November.
- Two teams of 10 players & 1 goalie – a Midget Minor A and a Midget Major A. The teams will be divided by grade level – Seniors and Juniors playing Midget Major and Sophomore and Freshman playing Midget Minor.
- The Pre-Season consists of 12 Monday dry lands, 17 ice practices and at least 8 games.
  - Dryland – Monday's 3:30 – 4:30PM beginning Monday, August 16 (excluding Monday, September 6<sup>th</sup> Labor Day Holiday) concluding November 8th.  
*NOTE: Dryland will be run by Coach Phil and either the current Avs' Trainer for 5 to 6 weeks or another certified trainer.*  
*A small fee will be assessed to players partaking in dryland but not playing on a Fall-Pre-Season Tournament team.*
  - Ice Practice – Tuesday's and Thursday's 4:00 – 5:00 PM at Old Foothills beginning Tuesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> and concluding Thursday, November 4<sup>th</sup> (excludes Thursday, September.

- A vote was taken and it was decided that we would offer the invite to two non-Mullen skaters to partake in the Fall Pre-Season Tournament team.
- Fees for Fall Pre-Season Tournament play will be decided shortly & an email notifying players of the total fee due and the due date will be sent.

**Winter Hockey:**

- Fees are estimated to be \$600-\$800, JV will be slightly higher than Varsity due to one extra tournament as well as the JV team must pay coaches (Varsity coaches are covered by the school).
- Players who play both JV & Varsity (swing players) will not pay an additional fee this year.
- JV will take two mountain trips this season
- Mullen rules dictate that on any CHSAA league there will be no non-Mullen player. We are asking permission for non-Mullen goalies (goalies who also do not play at CHSAA ruled schools) for our CHSAA/Varsity Team. Our JV Team is fine.
- CA is no longer part of the Mullen Hockey program.
- The CCYHL and CDYHL leagues have combined this year at the JV Club level so our JV team will be playing 11 to 14 teams this season.

**MISC –**

All players must be registered with USA Hockey for the 2010/2011 season in order to play for Mullen on JV, Varsity &/or the Tournament Team.

*Note: When you register with USA Hockey you should get one free Av's Ticket.*

We are in need of a JV Team Manager, Varsity Team Manager, and a Tournament Team Manager!

The next Mullen Hockey Booster meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 21st at 6:30 PM at Mullen in the Activity Center (Old Library).
