The minutes from our July, 2010 meeting were approved (Debra Lee motioned and Bob Ghia second).

The following was discussed during the meeting:

PRESEASON (NO LONGER CALLED PRESEASON/TOURNAMENT) -

Practices, Dryland and Tournament dates & times will be listed on Mullen Hockey Website.

Practices are Tuesday & Thursdays at Old Foothills from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM (there will be no ice on Thursday, September 30th due to the Mullen golf Tournament at 1:30 PM that day). The last ice practice for Preseason is Thursday, November 4th.

Open skate for Winter Season (all Varsity and JV players (all Fresh-Seniors) welcome) will be Monday & Wednesday, November 8th & 10th 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM at Edge. That same week (Tuesday & Thursday, November 9th & 11th) all Freshman and Sophomores will have ice practice from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM at Old Foothills.

Tryouts for Winter Season will be Friday, November 12th from 10:00 AM – 11:30 AM at School and then 1:15 PM – 2:45 PM at Old Foothills (ALL PLAYERS WILL TRYOUT).

Dryland is every Monday at school from 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM. The last dryland will be Monday, November 1st.

Tim Murray of ITS is conducting dryland training.

Dryland and Ice practices are MANDATORY for all Preseason players. Any player not able to make a dryland and/or ice practice must contact Coach Levy direct via phone or email.

Tournaments are Littleton Early Bird September 24-27 (see AYHL website & emails for detailed times).

Players are to wear a **Mullen school polo (color of their choice), khaki pants and dress shoes to all Tournament games. No hats!**

Second Tournament is Vail on November 5-7.

The team will plan one Team meal together in Vail once the schedule is known.

We do not have a Thanksgiving or Christmas tournament or games for either JV or Varsity.

Christmas Break – No practices allowed for Varsity from Dec 21st – Dec 25th. Dec 27th – 31st we will be allowed to hold optional Varsity practices at Old Foothills. Dates and times will be published.

Transportation to Varsity away games will be reviewed. Two games (Aspen & Summit) were budgeted for a bus to take the players. Co. Springs, Fountain Valley and Louis Palmer are the other 3 far games that will be reviewed for a bus otherwise players will be responsible for getting to those (& other closer away games) on their own.

JV Winter Team will play one tournament – the Littleton Slap Shot Tournament over Martin Luther King weekend January 14-17th.

The furthest away games for JV will be Windsor (twice).
