

# Open Skate Rink Rules

**We want you all to have fun on the ice, but skate SAFELY!**

- No, swearing, spitting, or hitting others
- No chipping the ice with skates
- No playing Tag or Crack the Whip
- No sitting on the wall edge of the players benches or going behind the players benches
- No excessive speed, stay in control and be able to stop
- No hockey sticks, hockey pucks, bouncy balls or other toys on the ice
- No taking hats, mittens or scarves off of other skaters
- No calling names or making fun of other skaters
- The Beginners area is for inexperienced skaters and their parents/guardians only- no fast skating or jumping over the dividers
- No gum chewing on the ice
- No food or drink on the ice
- If an area is marked with cones or tape, stay out of that area
- No sitting at the scorer's table or in the penalty boxes
- The hallway is for those who are putting on or returning rental skates
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products or weapons are allowed at open skate under any circumstances
- Violation of these rules may result in any or all of the following actions, a) you will be asked to leave, b) a report will be filed, c) your parents and/or police will be called, d) you may be banned from future open skate sessions.
- The Ice Wolves Parents or On-Ice Official (in the orange vest) has the right to enforce all the above rules and take needed measures to ensure the safety of all skaters.
