## **Travel Papers for Sanctioned Tournaments Eliminated in Region IV**

### **Most States also Eliminate Team Releases for Out of State Leagues**

Every State Association in US Youth Soccer Region IV has recently signed a Memo of Understanding that eliminates the need for teams to obtain travel papers prior to traveling to any other state in the Region to participate in state-sanctioned tournaments. Essentially a traveling team only needs to notify its home state association prior to travel. Travel papers for "friendly matches" are also no longer required, except for games involving teams from Cal-South and Arizona. Most state associations in Region IV (again with the exception of Cal-South, Arizona and Hawaii) have also eliminated the need for teams to be "released" from their home state association in order to play in a sanctioned out-of-state league.
