

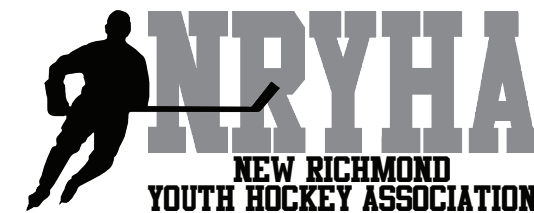
NEW RICHMOND YOUTH HOCKEY ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENTS FORMAT

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All NRYHA Tournaments are sanctioned by USAH therefore, all USAH rules and regulations will be enforced unless modified by the NRYHA Tournament Committee.
2. Properly certified team rosters must be submitted to the tournament director at registration check-in. All players must be registered on the USA Hockey roster.
3. A team roster must be furnished to the scorekeeper thirty (30) minutes prior to game time. Coaches' certification numbers and telephone numbers should be included.
4. The top team in the pairings for the game will be the 'home' team except that New Richmond will always be designated the 'home' team. The home team will wear its light colored jersey.
5. Each team should be in their assigned locker room thirty (30) minutes prior to the designated start time for their game and ready to come on the ice when the buzzer sounds.
6. Ice Resurfacing:
 - Mite/Squirt - Ice resurfaced after each game.
 - Girls - Ice resurfaced after each game.
 - PeeWee/Bantam - Ice resurfaced after every two periods.
 - Midgets/Senior Mens - Ice resurfaced after every two periods.
7. Period Lengths:
 - Mite/Squirt/Girls U10 - 12 minute periods.
 - Girls U12/Girls U14 - 13 minute periods.
 - PeeWee/Bantam - 15 minute periods.
 - Midgets/Senior Mens - 15 minute periods.

Tournaments for PeeWee level and above will have running time 1st and 2nd periods with stoppages at goals, to assess a penalty, for injuries or at the direction of the on-ice officials. Once the puck is dropped to restart the play, running time resumes. Running time continues during the serving of all penalties. If a penalty expires during a stoppage of play, the penalized player must remain in the penalty box until the puck is dropped to start play. If a player is serving a penalty that must wait for a stoppage of play (e.g. misconduct, coincidental minors), the player may return to the ice during the stoppage if it does not hold up play. Otherwise, the player must wait until the next stoppage of play. 3rd period is stop time.
8. During any game, if a team is ahead by more than six goals, running time will be used until the margin is lower than six goals. Stop time will then be resumed.
9. Each team will be allowed one 1 minute time-out per game.
10. There are no tie games. All tie games will go to a shoot-out.
Shoot-out Format:
The last five (5) skaters on the ice at the end of the third period are the skaters to compete in the shoot-out. If the score is still tied after the 5-on-5 shoot-out, a 2-on-2 shoot-out will start with two (2) players from each team different from the first five players. If the score is still tied after this shoot-out round, following 2-on-2 shoot-outs will continue until a winner is decided with any players of the coaches' choice competing. If a player is serving a penalty at the end of the game that is going to a shoot-out, that player cannot compete in the first 5-on-5 round of the shoot-out, the player can compete in the 2-on-2 rounds.
11. Round Robin Tournament Scoring will be used to determine standing for the Medal Round on Sunday for Round Robin Tournaments.
Points will be awarded as follows:
Win - 1 point.
Loss - 0 point.
Tie breaker rules for standings:
 - 1 - Head to Head competition.
 - 2 - Total Goals For (more).
 - 3 - Total Goals Against (less).
 - 4 - Coin Toss.
12. Only referees registered with USA Hockey will be used.
13. All decisions of the referees are final. Judgment calls by the referees can not be challenged. The on-ice referees and Tournament Director have the final interpretation of any tournament rule.
14. Trophies will be awarded as follows:
Eight Team brackets: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and Consolation Champion.
Round Robin brackets: 1st and 2nd place.
15. ANY abuse will not be tolerated. NRYHA is a NO-tolerance Association.
