

# BIG NINE Girls Youth Basketball League 2011

Standings will be kept of the teams win-loss record, with head-to-head & least points allowed as the tiebreaker.

## 6th & 7th Grade :

Each teams will play every team once.

A playoff will conclude the league with seedings based on League standings.

## 8th Grade :

Teams that play more than once will have only one of the games count toward standings (other game is exhibition) - indicated SHADED.

A playoff will conclude the league with seedings based on League standings.

## Competition Rules

All games played by MSHSL Rules with the following exceptions:

- Games will be 14 MINUTE Halves stop time
- 5 minutes between halves
- 6 minute warmup. Games should start as close as possible to On-Schedule. If there are back-to-back games, no less than 10 minutes between games (unless both coaches agree to start early)
- 2 Time-outs (1 minute time-outs) per Half (no carry-over)
- **Overtime Rules**
  - 2 minute overtimes (as many as necessary)
  - 1 minute between OTs
  - 1 Time-out per OT (no carry-over from regulation or prior OT)
- **Pressing Rules**
  - No pressing after 15 point lead
  - **Running Clock :** Clock will run after **20 point lead in 2nd half**. Clock will continue to run once started, unless lead is drop to 10 points or less.
  - Technical fouls are not shot (2 pts awarded and the ball).
  - A coach or player will be ejected from the game if 2 technical fouls (for misconduct) are issued.
- If a coach is ejected from the game, they will be asked to leave the bench area. Should further problems persist, they may be removed from the gym.

Note that MSHSL rules require a minimum of a 1 game suspension. Thus, the coach will not be allowed to coach the following game in this tournament. Any additional action will be evaluated by the Board of Directors of Sponsoring Basketball associations.
