The inning time is measured from the time the last out is recorded in an inning, to the time the pitcher is ready to pitch to the batter (on the rubber, ready to take sign). At one minute, the on-bench timer calls out to the catcher, and the catcher will throw down to second. The warmup count, counts the number of warmup pitches made between half innings. In the first inning for both pitchers, the timer starts when the pitcher steps on the rubber for the first warm up pitch.
