RULES

Pool Play Rules

Point determination: Win = 2 Points Tie = 1 Point Lose = 0 Points

The Team with the most points from each pool will advance to the Championship Round

Each team must supply one person for the penalty box

- No time outs

Championship Rounds

In the event of a tie at the end of regulation, teams will play the following:

- 4 on 4 = 5 minutes

- 3 on 3 = 5 minutes

- Shoot out - Best of 5 (5 shooters per team)

If still tied - sudden death shootout

(player can not shoot twice)

- No time outs

Pool Play Tie-breaker

1). Head-to-head between tied teams (Win=2 pts / Tie=1 pt / Lose =0 pt)

2). Fair Play Points in pool play

3). Fewest goals allowed (max 7 goals per game)

4). Most goals scored (max 7 goals per game)

5). Goal differential between all teams in pool (highest advanced)

6). Fewest # of penalties between all tied teams

7). Coin toss by Tournament Director (2 referee or officials present)

In the event of a 3 team tie, the tie-breaker process will be followed until 1 team is eliminated. The pool winner will be determined between the 2 remaining tied teams by following tie-breaker rule #1 again.
