I played club soccer with the Santa Anita Soccer Club in U – 19 super league when I was 15, 16, 17. During the same period – I was an All League and All CIF player at Temple City HS from 1978 – 1981. I was a member of the United States U 16 National team in 1978.

I went to Division I University of the Pacific from 1981 – 1983 and played soccer while on a scholarship for football as a kicker. I was going to join the San Jose Earthquakes in a tryout with former NASL San Jose Earthquakes coach Laurie Calloway who was the UOP gameday announcer when the NASL folded following the 1984 season.

I then played in the Southern California Professional Soccer League from 1985 – 1993 and began my coaching career in 1985 as an assistant coach with Estancia HS winning the Div III CIF championship. In 1988 I took a JV job at Villa Park HS and was 19 – 1 – 3 in my first year. I then took an assistant coach job in 1989 at Division I Cal State Los Angeles with present Women’s National Team Coach of Mexico – Leonardo Cuellar and worked for two years with him while finishing my teaching credential in Physical Education. While still at CSLA I returned to Villa Park as the Head Varsity Coach where we reached the playoffs every year from 1990 – 1994.

In 1994 I took over at Whittier College as the Head Men’s Coach and guided the team to 36 victories over 4 seasons when prior to my arrival they had only 9 combined wins in the previous 5 seasons before my arrival. In the same years 1994 – 1998 I was a PE teacher and Head HS coach at Whittier HS where I guided them to their first ever appearances in the CIF playoffs each year.

In 1999 – I left both Whittier HS and Whittier College to retire from coaching and just teach PE in Long Beach. It lasted one day – as on my arrival to Cabrillo I was asked to begin a Varsity program. 172 – 57 – 24 games later and with State and National Rankings as high as # 1, I am still at Cabrillo and have no plans to retire. After the 2004 season I took over as Head Coach at Long Beach City College with Cameron Beaulac as my Co – Head Coach and have enjoyed the playoffs and National Rankings as high as # 4 in 5 of our 7 years.
