Dear Bob:

I saw the Crain's article yesterday and am sure you and Ed are getting inundated with phone calls and questions from employees, members, customers, etc. As you know, the filing discussed in the article does not affect the operations of the rink or the Huskies. You and Ed Nickey are still in charge of managing the International Ice Centre ("IIC") just like you have been for over a year. In that respect, nothing at the rink has changed.

For the past six-plus months we have been working with you in cooperation with representatives of the bondholders to prepare and market the facility for sale. The filing is just normal course in these types of situations and provides a roadmap for the eventual buyer to gain ownership of the facility...nothing more.

Our marketing efforts are beginning to bear fruit as we have received a number of indications of interest from well financed, qualified prospective buyers. In fact, we are currently discussing the sale with potential interested parties and are in the process of documenting the process. Confidentiality prohibits me from mentioning names, but suffice it to say that they are all familiar with skating and have the financial wherewithal to move forward.

Barring any surprises, I would expect to have an agreement finalized in the coming few weeks. After that, we'll work on a date for the sale, most likely mid-April, but that will be dependent on the schedules of others that is outside of our control. At that point, the IIC facility will be under new ownership. New ownership that will not have the debt issues mentioned in the article as the sale will be an all-cash sale.

All of the prospective buyers we have talked to have indicated that they want you and the Huskies to remain in place under their new ownership and look forward to helping you continue to grow your membership in the future. The Huskies will be an important and integral part of the new owners plans. Come later this year, you and the Huskies will just be dealing with a new "landlord".

Bob, I hope this clarifies things a bit. But if you, the Huskies membership or members of any of the other teams at the IIC have any questions, feel free to have them call me. Better yet, if you think it would be helpful, maybe you and Ed could schedule a meeting of the various parties and I can walk them through what we are doing and what they can expect in the coming few months. Just let me know.
