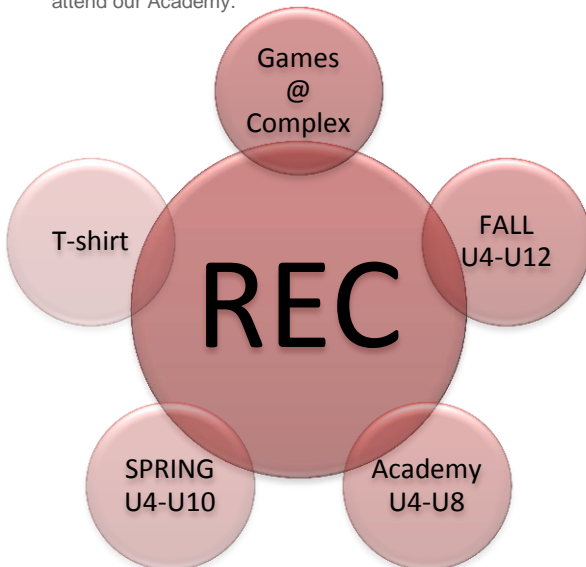

## Rec Soccer is

- Ages 4-12 years old/boys & girls

- One week night, along with Saturday morning
- Teams are divided by gender & age (4-5, 6-7, 8-9,10-12)
- Spring Rec alternates Training and Games
- Fall Rec begins with 4 Training sessions, followed by 11 Games, ending the season with a Tournament
- Coaches are Parent Volunteers
- Trainers are hired, qualified, experienced trainers
- All players receive an SSA T-shirt, in their team color

- Have some soccer experience
- Multiple competitive levels (C3, C2, C1)
- Game nights are either M/W or T/Th
- Practices vary by team and coach
- Travel is expected and required
- Ages 9-12 Age Group Trainers with Qualified Coaches
- Ages 13+ Qualified coaches
- Futsal is played in a gym, developing fast foot skills
- Winter Training is facilitated by age group and gender
- Street Soccer is an organized set of pick-up games
- Indoor Teams participate in league play at Soccer Blast
- Uniforms are required and reused for 2- 3 years
- Fall Travel for ages 9-12
- Fall School Soccer is encouraged for 13+ (Grades 7-12)
