SSA Soccer School- Goalkeeper Training U9-U12:

What: Goalkeeper Training is for U9-U12 players who are learning the position. The focus of the training is to teach the basics: catching, punting, diving, positioning

When: Sundays: April 24-May 22 and June 6-June 26, 6:30pm-7:30pm at the Soccer Complex

Who: U9-U12 Players interested in learning the basics of GK

Staff: An SSA GK coach will lead the sessions along with assistance from S.H.S. goalkeepers.

Cost: No Charge to any SSA registered player

SSA Summer Street Soccer:

Street Soccer is open to all who are able to make it. Street Soccer is free of charge and an opportunity for players to play the game with their peers during the day.
