

# Mohn helps power Westmont to a pair of girls softball wins

Allie Mohn knows how to knock a softball around the field, and she did it enough last week to help the Westmont girls softball team to a couple of wins in the Mt. Hamilton Division of the Blossom Valley Athletic League.

Westmont won two of three games last week, beating Leigh 11-2 and Pioneer 9-2 but losing 7-1 to Mt. Pleasant, to improve to 7-1 in league play and to 14-3 overall. The Warriors have this week off and will pick it up again when they Piedmont Hills on April 19 at 3:30 p.m.

Mohn smacked three hits, including a double, and she also drove in a run for Westmont to help the Warriors defeat Leigh 11-2 on April 7. She also homered and knocked in three runs in the win over Pioneer two days earlier.

Leigh actually had a 1-0 lead after an inning, but Westmont tied the game 1-1 in the second. The Longhorns took another lead 2-1 in the middle of the third, but Westmont decided enough was enough and rallied for three runs in the bottom of the third to take the lead once and for all. The Warriors continued on the offensive with two in the fourth and another two in the fifth. Westmont finished it with three in the bottom of the sixth.

Mohn led the team with her bat, while Sarina Araujo followed by ripping a pair of singles and driving in two. Lujane Mussadi smacked two hits and had an RBI, Sarah Ossello, Casey Morris and Rebeka Brown each singled and drove in runs and Cassidy Brown belted a hit and had two RBIs.

Mussadi topped the rubber

for all seven innings and struck out four.

Westmont's other win came over Pioneer 9-2 on April 5. The Warriors scored enough for the win in the first three with three runs before the Mustangs scored one in the bottom of the third. Westmont scored again in the top of the fourth. Pioneer scored one more in the bottom of the fifth before Westmont finished it off with one in the top of the sixth and four more in the top of the seventh.

Mussadi hammered two hits and drove in two, Ossello smacked two singles and had an RBI, Ortiz ripped two hits and Mohn ripped the homer. Christine Kuhny roped a double, Morris singled and drove in a run and C. Brown, R. Brown and Araujo each singled in the win.

Westmont's loss last week came at the hands of Mt. Pleasant 7-1 on April 6. C. Brown smashed a pair of hits, Haley Halkovic singled and drove in the only run and R. Brown, Ortiz, Mohn and Ossello each singled in the loss.
